



Senior Planning Calendar 2026-2027

**This list is not comprehensive, and all dates are subject to change.*

May-August

- Take your final SAT/ACT before submitting applications
- Continue to revise college essays
- Attend summer essay boot camps
- Secure letters of recommendation
- Finalize your resume
- Attend **Senior Summit on August 15, 2026**
- Register for the **ACT at TMA - September 19, 2026**

September

- Finalize your Early Action, Early Decision, and Priority Applications
- Update SCOIR to reflect applications submitted
- Create a spreadsheet to keep track of application, materials, and financial aid deadlines for each college you are applying to.
- Attend the Florida Christian College Fair at TMA – *September 15, 2026*
- Write thank-you notes to all recommenders
- **Attend Quads** (Questions, Answers, and Desserts)
- Continue to attend college visits at TMA and on college campuses
- Register for the **SAT at TMA - October 29, 2026**
- Ensure all test scores have been sent directly to colleges through your College Board or ACT account. See guidance for help if needed.
- Attend the **Christian College Fair - September 15, 2026**

October

- Submit all state university applications before deadlines
- Attend Financial Aid Night at TMA - October 19, 2026
- You will need to complete the **2027-2028 FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
 - The **2027-2028 FAFSA** will open on **October 1, 2026**. You and your parents will need your **2025 tax information** to complete the application.
- Continue to update SCOIR as you submit applications
- Attend **Senior Writing day - October 14, 2026**
- Attend the **FAFSA Workshop - October 19, 2026**
- Attend **Financial Aid night - October 19, 2026**
- **Keep a log of all college portal log-in information and emails.** You will have unique login credentials for each college you apply to.
- Check your email often

November

- Continue testing - ACT/SAT if needed

- Continue submitting applications and updating SCOIR as needed
- Continue visiting college campuses
- Check your email often

December

- Update SCOIR with college decisions
- Finish submitting regular decision college applications
- Ensure test scores have been sent to regular decision colleges
- Apply for scholarships diligently for the next several months
- Check your email and college application portals often

January

- Update SCOIR. This ensures that the registrar will send your updated transcript to all colleges to which you've applied
- Work on scholarship applications
- Attend Career Visits
- Check your email and college application portals often

February

- Attend College Night at TMA – *February 16, 2027*
- Attend Central Florida College Fair at TMA – *February 27, 2027*
- Attend the Bright Futures Lab - February 17 & 18 during Bible Classes
- Attend Career Visits
- Check your email and college application portals often

March

- Prep for AP exams
- Visit colleges that you've been accepted to before making final decisions
- Check your email often

April

- Prep for AP exams
- Attend the *All Senior Meeting* with Guidance on April 8th, during FLEX
- Finalize college decisions and update SCOIR
- Attend your scheduled senior meetings with guidance
- Research and apply for summer jobs, internships, volunteer opportunities, camps, college courses, or enrichment programs
- Submit final community service hours to the registrar
- Check your email often

May

- **May 1 - Decision Day - You must notify colleges of your final decision by this date and update SCOIR**
- Notify other colleges that you will not be accepting enrollment
- Submit the Bright Futures Application if you have not already done so
- AP Exams: *May 3-14, 2027*
- Graduation: *May 14, 2027*
