**Evacuation Center:** Reno-Sparks Convention Center, Hall 4, 4590 S Virginia St — Enter via Kietzke Lane, Door 20F

**Small Animals:** Washoe County Regional Animal Services, 2825 Longley Ln, Reno (do NOT bring pets to evacuation center)

**Large Animals:** Ironwood Event Center, 5600 Whiskey Springs Rd — Enter at second driveway, check in at main office

**RED Zone:** Leave Now

**YELLOW Zone:** Be Prepared to Leave

## ⚡ THE 6 P's OF PREPAREDNESS — Pack these first if you must evacuate ⚡

#### People & Pets

Family members, pets, service animals, and neighbors who may need help evacuating.

#### Papers & Docs

IDs, insurance, medical records, passports, birth certificates, and emergency contacts.

#### Prescriptions & Meds

Prescription medications, vitamins, eyeglasses, hearing aids, and medical equipment.

#### Photos & Keepsakes

Irreplaceable photos, heirlooms, sentimental items, and personal memorabilia.

#### Personal Devices

Phone, laptop, chargers, backup drives, and any critical personal electronics.

#### Plastic & Cash

Credit cards, debit cards, ATM cards, and enough cash for immediate emergency needs.
