DSA Athletic Eligibility Information 26-27

Dear Scholars and Parents/Guardians,

In an effort to provide every scholar the opportunity to be academically and athletically successful at Desert Star Academy, the following guidelines will be implemented for the 2026-2027 school year when it comes to academic eligibility for participation in the school's athletic interscholastic programs.

***Note:** Only Scholars with adequate credits earned, based on their grade level, are eligible at the start of each season of sport as determined by the AIA. See DSA Athletic Handbook for adequate credit breakdown.*

- Grade checks will be conducted every Monday at the start of the school day.
- Any scholar **failing to meet the grade requirement of 70% or higher in one or more of his/her classes** will be put on "academic probation", meaning they will be allowed to participate in any games and practices for that week as long as they are attending lunch and after school tutoring sessions, attending Friday school (when available), and turning in any missing/incomplete assignments.
- If a scholar on "academic probation" is passing all classes with a 70% or higher the next week (*as per the grade checks done every Monday*) they will no longer be on "academic probation" and will return to being on good academic standing & eligibility.
- If a scholar on "academic probation" fails to meet the grade requirement of 70% or higher in one or more of his/her same classes for second week in a row (*as per the grade checks done every Monday*) they will be ineligible to participate in any games, activities, or tournaments that week. The scholar will need to continue to attend tutoring sessions and make an effort to improve his/her grade to that of a passing score.
- If a scholar on "academic probation" fails to meet the grade requirement of 70% or higher in one or more of his/her same classes for a third week in a row (*as per the grade checks done every Monday*) they may be dismissed from the team (final decision will be made by coach & athletic director).
