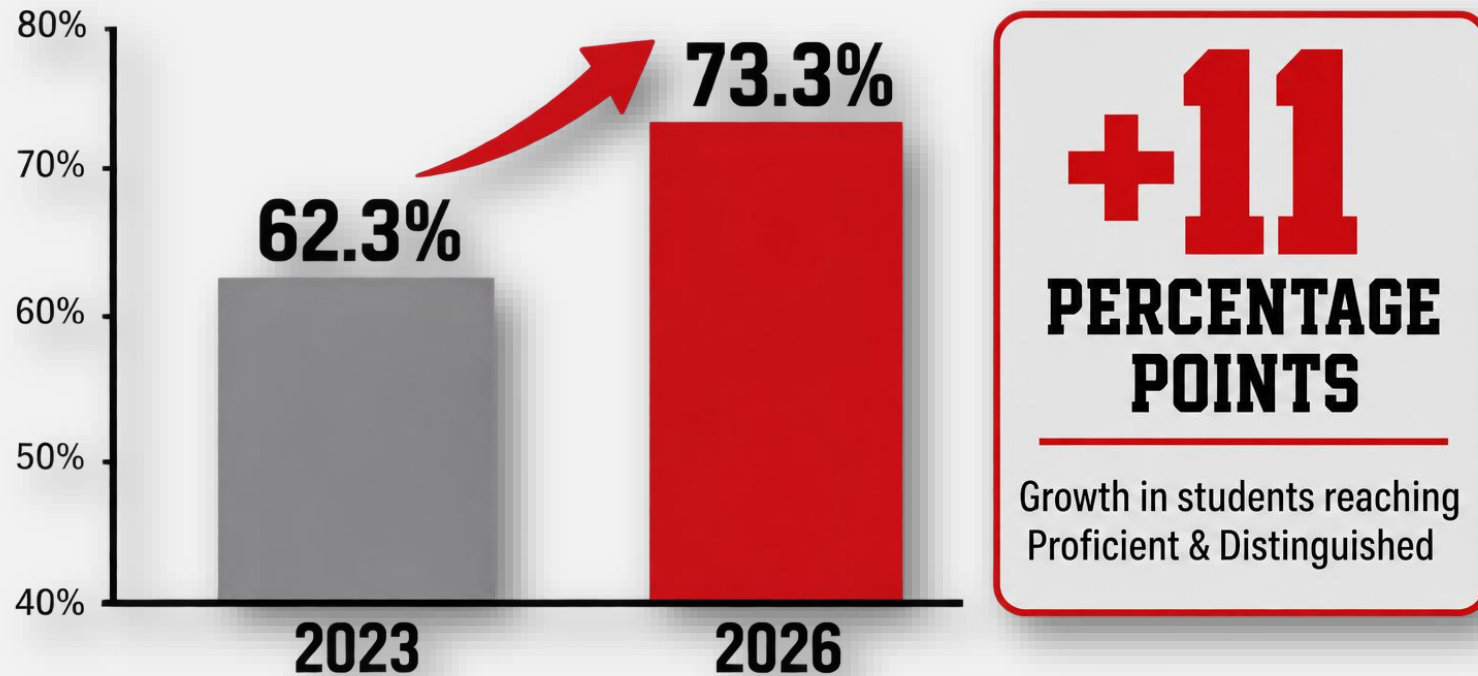

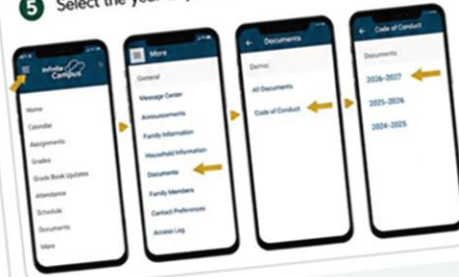

Personal Remote Days

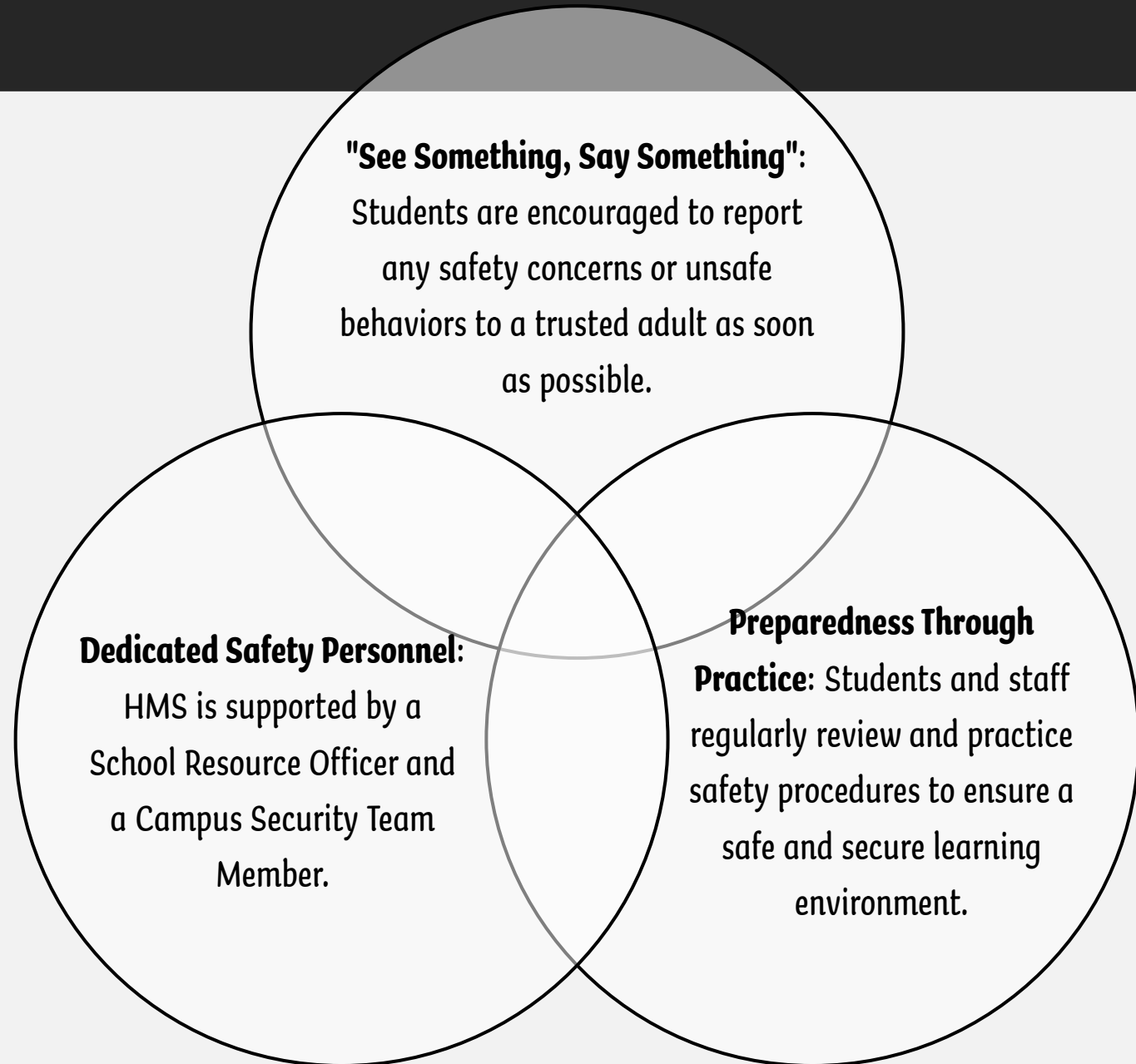
Students are allowed 5 remote learning days per semester, to get approved for a remote learning day, email your grade level AP at least 5 days prior for approval.
