PROGRAM

CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

The Board of Trustees shall provide a program of career and technical education to prepare students for gainful employment as entry-level workers, technicians or semiprofessionals in recognized and emerging occupations. The career and technical educational program should assist students in making informed and meaningful career and postsecondary education decisions.

The Board will support a program of career and technical education, which may include career and technical courses of study as part of the regular school curriculum and cooperative education programs that offer students work-based learning experiences or internships, provided such programs are integrated with the student's regular school program.

A pupil who successfully completes a program of career and technical education and otherwise satisfies the requirements for graduation from high school must be awarded a high school diploma with an endorsement indicating that the pupil has successfully completed the program of career and technical education. This requirement does not preclude a pupil from receiving more than one endorsement on his or her diploma, if applicable.
