PROGRAM

ADULT EDUCATION

The Board of Trustees may establish and maintain an adult high school education to provide eligible adult residents with an opportunity to earn a high school diploma or adult standard diploma in accordance with Nevada law.

The Board may employ staff and utilize school facilities as required to support an adult high school education program, including through day, evening, or alternative delivery models. The Superintendent may assign appropriate staff and facilities and shall ensure that any adult high school program operated by the District complies with NAC 387.190, NAC 387.330, and other applicable standards prescribed by the Nevada Department of Education.

The Board directs the Superintendent or designee to develop and maintain administrative regulations governing eligibility, enrollment, curriculum, scheduling, assessment, and graduation requirements for any adult high school program, consistent with Nevada law and State Board of Education regulations.
