PROGRAM

EVALUATION OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

The purpose of this policy is to ensure Board oversight of the effectiveness of the District's educational program and compliance with Nevada Academic Content Standards and required courses of study.

The Board of Trustees shall regularly evaluate the effectiveness of the District's educational program using indicators of student progress toward the attainment of the educational objectives of the Board and the Nevada Academic Content Standards.

The Board shall enforce in all District schools:

1. The standards of content and performance established by the Council to Establish Academic Standards for Public Schools pursuant to NRS 389.520 and the courses of study related to those standards; and
2. The courses of study prescribed and adopted by the State Board of Education.

The Board directs the Superintendent or designee to develop and maintain administrative regulations and procedures for curriculum, assessment, and program evaluation that ensure enforcement of these standards and courses of study in every school.

This policy shall be implemented in coordination with Board policies on curriculum, assessment, and school improvement planning.
