FINE ARTS EDUCATION

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all students have access to a comprehensive fine arts education, including visual, performing, and media arts, as an integral component of a well-rounded education.

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that the curriculum framework for each fine arts course is aligned with applicable Nevada Academic Content Standards and other board-adopted standards, and that it is reviewed on a regular cycle and revised as necessary to maintain rigor, relevance, and consistency across the District. As appropriate, academic competencies and standards shall be integrated into fine arts courses in ways that strengthen student learning while preserving the integrity of the fine arts disciplines.

The District shall strive to provide equitable access to fine arts education for all students, including those from underserved groups and students with disabilities, consistent with applicable law and board policies.

The Superintendent or designee is responsible for implementing this policy and may develop administrative regulations to provide additional guidance for the delivery, evaluation, and improvement of fine arts programs.
