ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI) ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

Purpose & Intent

Douglas County School District recognizes the transformative potential of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in education and operations. This policy, with its supporting regulation, establishes guiding principles for ethical, equitable, and transparent AI use by all students, staff, and partners. Our intent is to enhance learning, foster innovation, uphold academic integrity, and ensure compliance with Nevada law.

Key Expectations

- AI shall support educational, professional, or administrative goals—not replace human judgment.
- All AI use must be transparent, secure, and respectful of privacy, intellectual property, and equity.
- AI platforms may not be used for direct mental/behavioral health services, as outlined in AB 406.
- Students and staff are accountable for evaluating AI outputs for accuracy, appropriateness, and bias.
- All users must follow district rules on academic honesty, data handling, and responsible technology use.

Oversight & Approval

Only district-approved AI platforms may be used. Requests must be reviewed for educational value, compliance, security, and risk. The district will monitor usage, provide training, and periodically update policy as AI evolves.
