FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Arrival and Drop Off:

- Doors open to all students at 8:35 AM. Students are considered late after 8:50 AM.
- If you are dropping off your student in the morning, please pull into the car rider entrance on Washington Avenue any time from 8:25 AM to 8:49 AM, turn right into the playground area. Proceed around the playground area back toward the little circle at the end of the primary wing. Pull to the front of the drop-off line in the little circle.
- Students must exit and enter cars from the right-hand side of the car for their safety. Drivers should remain in their cars, at all times. Staff will assist children with instruments or anything else they need.
- Please exit by using the car rider entrance by which you entered the school property.
- If you are going to pick up your child on a regular basis, a form must be completed allowing your child to be a car rider on a specific day or days. This form is located on our website under the Families tab. If there is a change to your child's dismissal, please write a note and indicate who will be picking up your child.
- All families are given two signs containing your student's last name. If you misplaced your signs, please notify the office. Please keep this sign in the passenger side windshield during afternoon pick-up. All new families will be receiving two signs containing your student's last name.

Attendance:

- Parents/guardians are required to report their child's absence, late arrival and/or early departure in SafeArrival using one of three methods:
 1. Use the SchoolMessenger app downloaded to a mobile device
 2. Call the toll-free number: 1-888-292-9573

- Parents/guardians may also call the school at 215-257-9200 or email WREAttendance@pennridge.org to report an absence, late arrival and/or early departure.
- Absences shall be deemed 'unlawful' unless the school receives a written excuse explaining the reason for the absence within three (3) days of the absence. A detailed analysis regarding truancy can be found at www.elc-pa.org/truancy.

Clearances and Raptor:

- To volunteer at any school/classroom event or to chaperone a field trip you must have current clearances on file with the district. Once issued, clearances are valid for five years.
- When applying for clearances, begin the process well in advance of when you want to start volunteering to ensure the process is completed in time for your date of service. Feel free to contact the District Office prior to making a trip to turn in your clearances at 215-257-5011.

 - After you are fingerprinted, within 24 to 48 hours, you will receive an email message from Identogo with your certificate. (We are unable to use the receipt from your appointment). Please print your certificate and bring it to the DAO along with the other 3 clearances and your driver's license. We will verify your clearance documents and you will be put into the Raptor system.

Parent Portal:

- It is imperative that each parent/guardian logs into PowerSchool Parent Portal annually to verify and update your student's information. The information is not updated until you press **submit** and receive confirmation. The Tylenol and Antacid releases, Emergency Contact emails and phone numbers, Media Authorization, Computer User Agreement, etc. are all on this site.
