

ATHLETIC REMINDERS & UPDATES FOR 2026-2027

- **REQUIRED ANNUAL CODE MEETING –THERE WILL BE AN IN-PERSON CODE MEETING FOR THIS SCHOOL YEAR.** The date for the required in-person code meeting for the 2026-2027 school year will be **MONDAY AUGUST 3RD, 2026** at Crivitz High School in the gymnasium starting at 7:00 p.m. **At least ONE parent/guardian must attend along with each student that wishes to participate in ANY co-curricular activities in the Crivitz School District for the 2026-2027 academic year.**
- **ACTIVITY/ATHLETIC PAPERWORK** – This process will be done again through ONLINE registration. The direct link for the online registration site is <https://www.arbiterlive.com/Teams?entityId=5313> **THIS IS A NEW ATHLETIC WEBSITE STARTING THIS YEAR.** We will also make this available on our school website. **This will be made available on July 15, 2026.** Please do not try to register before July 15, 2026.

Q: What do I need to do in advance, so that I am ready to go on that first day of practice?

You will need an alternate year card or a physical completed before the first day of practice. The **PAPER form will need to be filled out and turned into the office.** The alternate year card may be filled out online but the sports physical **CANNOT be turned in online.** The below forms will be accessible online (with the exception of the sports physical form under your family account.)

- i) **WIAA Athletic Permit Card (Physical Card)** – This card certifies that the student has had a physical and is physically able to compete. This card is kept on file and is valid for two (2) school years for all Crivitz High School/Middle School athletic teams. The green card is the physical card; the yellow card is for alternate years. **Schedule an appointment with your doctor early in the summer! Not having a physical or having to wait for an appointment to open is normally the biggest problem for athletes not being able to start practice on time at the beginning of the season.**
- ii) **CHS/CMS Activities Code Handbook (Parent and Student Activities Code Contract)** – This contract obligates the student and the parent to comply with the rules as set forth in this Activities Code and the team standards as determined by the team coach. This contract is kept on file and is valid for one (1) year for all Crivitz High School/Middle School activities. (Complete at In-Person Meeting on August 3rd, 2026)
- iii) **WIAA Athlete Eligibility Information Bulletin (AEIB)/Medical Information Disclosure (Release Form), Medical Information** – these documents clarify rules regarding age, academics, attendance, residence, transfers, physicals, training rules, amateur status, and activities outside of school in addition to medical information needed for our athletic trainer. **PLEASE FILL OUT ALL FORMS TO THEIR ENTIRETY.** Physician's names/address/contact number, etc. are all required. (Online Registration)
- iv) **Transportation Liability Form**—Even if the student is riding the bus to and from away events, this form must be signed. **Specifics about our transportation policy for our co-curricular events will be explained at the in-person meeting.** (Online Registration)

Q: Can I begin practice without having the required paperwork turned into the school office?

No! The WIAA requires a completed WIAA Athletic Permit Card (Physical Card) and online registration to be on file in our office for each athlete participating on an athletic team. In addition, our Board of Education requires that the signed code contract be on file as well as all the medical forms/fees in order to participate. **ALL PAPERWORK IS REQUIRED TO BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING IN ANY PRACTICE.** If you are having issues with your online account, you may click on forgot password and a new password will be emailed to you.
