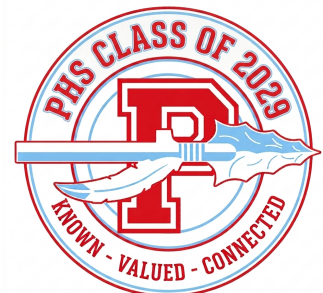
The foundation of my leadership is simple: **KNOWN, VALUED, and CONNECTED.**
