

Turner High School NAHS Bylaws

- Section 1: A chapter should include bylaws to amplify sections of its constitution. Bylaws do not need to be approved by the National Council if they are consistent with regulations outlined in the constitution. A current copy of the local chapter bylaws must be filed with NAEA.
- Section 2. **Service:** To remain a member in good standing, a member must pay dues and complete 10 service hours in the visual arts each year.
- Section 3. **Dues:** Annual dues of \$15 will be collected from each member. Additional fees may be required to cover any other expenses throughout the year.
- Section 4. **Attendance:** Attendance is required at meetings to maintain membership and privileges. Students may miss up to one meeting per month, unless prior arrangements have been made. Weekly meetings will be held each Thursday (Except the 2nd Thursday of each month).
- Section 5. **Participation:** All members must participate in 75% of our projects, activities, and fundraisers. Each member must enter at least 3 art contests per school year. Each member needs 15 hours in NAHS and 5 outside hours.
- Section 6. **Officers:** For the NAHS officers, attendance is also required at any executive meetings called outside of the regularly scheduled meetings. To run for office, members must have a 'B' average in all classes at the time of election.
- Section 7. **Seniors:** To graduate with NAHS honors and earn the right to wear a cord, pin, or tassel at graduation, a member must remain in good standing until the graduation date.
- Section 8. **Grades:** To join, members must retain a 'B' average in all classes. Members must have or have had an 'A' in their art class. Members must also maintain the 'B' average for each class throughout the year. If a member's grades fall below the required average, he/she will be put on probation and must recover the average within 2 progress reports (6 weeks).
- Section 9. **Average:** Members must have and maintain a 3.0 cumulative average in all other subjects.
- Section 10. **Art Classes:** Members may remain active during such time when there are no visual arts on their class schedules as long as they fulfill all of the other requirements each year.
- Section 11. **Rules:** In the event of an infraction of rules, a review by the officers and sponsors will be conducted. If the individual in question is an officer, he/she will not participate in the decision-making process. This applies to all community laws as well as school and chapter rules.
- Section 12. **Behavior:** Students must maintain good a behavioral standing in school. If a behavioral infraction occurs inside or outside the art classroom, the sponsor has the authority to ban the member from any further involvement in NAHS without refund. Also, if a student drops out of a major contest, he/she/they may be put on probation or be banned from future membership.
