PROGRAM

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT - INSTRUCTIONAL TECHNOLOGY

The Board of Trustees recognizes the responsibility for the quality of the educational program and the essential role of instructional technology in supporting pedagogy and student achievement. The Board directs that the District's technology program be assessed, revised, and evaluated on a regular basis to ensure alignment with academic standards and operational security.

In order to implement the Board Policy, the District shall develop, implement, evaluate, and maintain a comprehensive Technology Plan focused on equitable access, infrastructure reliability, and the integration of digital tools into the instructional environment.

The Technology Plan Shall address the lifecycle management of hardware and software, the security of student and staff data, and the provision of accessible digital resources for all learners.

The Technology Plan shall include a strategy to provide technical support programs to ensure effective use of instructional technology among students, parents, and staff. The Technology Plan shall include measurable goals, implementation timelines and responsibilities assigned by the administration.

Instructional technology shall be supported by continuous, high-quality professional learning opportunities. The Technology Plan shall include strategies and timelines for professional development to ensure that educators are proficient in leveraging digital tools to enhance student engagement and mastery of curriculum.
