PROGRAM

HOME SCHOOL STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND USE OF FACILITIES, EQUIPMENT AND INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPLIES

The Board of Trustees allows the participation of home-school students in District-sponsored extracurricular activities subject to applicable requirements and capacity limitations. The following guidelines must be adhered to:

- Parents/guardians must have a completed emergency medical/health information form on file with the school prior to participation.
- The student's parent(s)/guardian(s) must conference with the school's site administrator prior to participation in extracurricular activities to review applicable rules, expectations, and safety requirements.
- The student must comply with all rules and regulations required of enrolled students for participation in the activity, including applicable District, school, and activity/club/team rules.
- Enrolled students will be given preference when space in the extracurricular activity is limited (i.e., photography and computer clubs, etc.) or when participation is limited due to staffing, safety, equipment, or facility constraints.
- Transportation of students for extracurricular activities will be the responsibility of home-school parents/guardians, unless otherwise provided for all participants for a specific event.
- Use of school facilities (i.e., library, computer labs, etc.) and instructional material by home-school students may not detract from or displace the instructional opportunities of enrolled students and must occur in accordance with site schedules, supervision requirements, and facility rules.
- Participation of home-school students in interscholastic activities will be governed by official NIAA or other league regulations including eligibility requirements.
- If the District charges participation fees or requires purchases applicable to enrolled students (e.g., uniforms, equipment, club dues), the home school student is responsible for the same fees/costs unless waived pursuant to District policy and/or applicable law.
- Approval to participate may be denied, limited, or revoked for failure to maintain required documentation, violation of rules, safety concerns, or disruption to the activity/program.
