1. Academics & Attendance

Student athletes will:

- Attend school regularly and arrive on time.
- Maintain a 91% attendance rate during period of sport
- Complete classroom assignments and make academics a priority.
- Follow classroom expectations and demonstrate appropriate behavior.
- Maintain the school's academic and attendance eligibility requirements.

2. Respect & Sportsmanship

Student athletes will:

- Treat teammates, coaches, opponents, officials, staff, and spectators with respect.
- Use school-appropriate language at all times.
- Accept officials' and coaches' decisions appropriately.
- Win with humility and lose with dignity.
- Encourage teammates and demonstrate a positive attitude.
- Shake hands or demonstrate appropriate sportsmanship before or after competitions when

3. Practices & Games

Student athletes will:

- Understand that playing time is not guaranteed. Based on coach's discretion.
- Arrive on time, prepared for practices and games.
- Bring appropriate clothing, shoes, uniforms, and equipment.
- Follow coaches' directions.
- Participate safely and give their best effort.
- Notify the coach when they will miss a practice or game.
- Remain with the team until properly released to a parent/guardian or authorized adult.

4. Safe Behavior

Student-athletes will not:

- Fight, push, hit, kick, or intentionally hurt another person during school, practice, or games.
- Threaten, cyberbully, bully, harass, or intimidate others during school, practice, or games.
- Use profanity, inappropriate gestures, or offensive language during school, practice, or games.
- Use racial, discriminatory, or disrespectful comments during school, practice, or games.
- Damage or misuse of school, team, or another person's property.
- Leave practices, games, or designated areas without permission.

5. Representing Our School

Student athletes are expected to demonstrate appropriate conduct:

- During school day.
- At practices and games.
- While traveling to and from competitions.
- At other schools and athletic facilities.
- During team celebrations, awards, and school-sponsored events.
