UPSEU GRIEVANCE SETTLEMENTS

WHEREAS, the United Public Service Employees Union ("Union") filed a grievance against the District alleging that four of its members performed additional duties and responsibilities for which he had not been compensated for by the District; and

WHEREAS, during the 2025-2026 school year, Yassine Bajaj ("Bajaj"), Sherman Robinson ("Robinson"), Natsha Dixon ("Dixon") and Jahmal Henderson ("Henderson") allege that they each performed duties, entitling them to compensation for the additional duties pursuant to the parties' collective bargaining agreement ("CBA"); and

WHEREAS, the District has taken the position that it cannot pay an employee for performing additional duties; and

WHEREAS, the Union disputed the District's position that paying an employee for additional duties would violate any law, rule, regulation, or policy; and

WHEREAS, the Union has negotiated with the District's Superintendent, through the District's counsel, to resolve the allegations of pay for additional duties, on the conditions herein set forth; and

WHEREAS, the Union and the District desire to eliminate the need to hold a hearing to determine the validity of the Union's claims, as well as the District's defense to such claims, to resolve the dispute; and

WHEREAS, Bajaj, Robinson, Dixon, and Henderson through their Union representatives, after such consultations and review, freely consented to and entered into Stipulations to resolve each of their disputes with the District and disposing of the Union's grievances filed on their behalf against the District, on the basis of the terms contained in the Stipulations; now therefore it is

RESOLVED, that the District agrees to settle Bajjai's claim pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation between him and the District; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the District agrees to settle Robinson's claim pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation between him and the District; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the District agrees to settle Dixon's claim pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation between her and the District; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the District agrees to settle Henderson's claim pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation between her and the District; and it is further

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Hempstead Union Free School District desires to embark upon the following proposed capital project at the District's facility as set forth herein and as listed in the working budget: (1) replacement of the existing scoreboard with a new scoreboard including any related mechanical, electrical, infrastructure, safety, and building system improvements at the Hempstead High School (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, said capital improvements are subject to classification under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA); and

WHEREAS, maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing structure or facility are classified as Type II Actions under the current Department of Environmental Conservation SEQRA Regulations (Section 6 NYCRR 617.5 (c)(1)); and

WHEREAS, replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or a facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building or fire codes, unless such action meets or exceeds any of the thresholds in section 617.4 are classified as Type II Actions under the current Department of Environmental Conservation SEQRA Regulations (Section 6 NYCRR 617.5 (c)(2)); and

WHEREAS, routine activities of educational institutions, including expansion of existing facilities by less than 10,000 square feet of gross floor area are classified as Type II Actions under the current Department of Environmental Conservation SEQRA Regulations (Section 6 NYCRR 617.5 (c)(10)); and

WHEREAS, the purchase or sale of furnishings, equipment or supplies...other than the following: land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides, or other hazardous materials are classified as Type II Actions under the current Department of Environmental Conservation SEQRA Regulations (Section 6 NYCRR 617.5 (c)(31)); and

WHEREAS, the SEQRA Regulations declare Type II Actions to be actions that have no significant impact on the environment and require no further review under SEQRA; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education, as the only involved agency, has examined all information related to the capital improvement projects and has determined that the Projects are classified as Type II Actions pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(1), (2), (10), and (31) of the SEQRA Regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby declares itself lead agency in connection with the requirements of the State Environmental Quality Review Act; and
