



ALCOTT ELEMENTARY — AUGUST 2026 CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Dear Students, Families and Neighbors,

The Alcott construction team is excited to build your new school, and we want to tell you what's been happening on the job site!

WHAT WE'VE FINISHED:

- Installed reinforcing steel (rebar) for all slab-on-grade areas.
- Completed all slab-on-grade concrete pours.
- Installed under-slab mechanical, electrical and plumbing components, including branch lines, trap primers, and other embedded utilities.

WHAT'S COMING UP NEXT:

- Erecting the main structural steel frame for the new school building.
- Completing miscellaneous steel installation, connections and welding.
- Beginning to establish the building's overall structure as the project continues to take shape.

SAFETY TIPS:



- Trucks come 4–5 days a week between 7:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. Stay back and make sure drivers can see you.

- Listen to flaggers — they help keep everyone safe.
- Don't go inside fenced-off areas.

WHAT WE'RE WORKING ON NOW:

- Structural steel erection began on August 10, 2026.
- Layout and preparation for exterior/interior metal framing installation.
- Repaving the existing parking lot and installing new curbs to support ongoing site improvements.

WORKING HOURS

Standard work hours are

7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday–Friday.

We may need to work at night or on weekends.

Working hours will be in compliance with King County ordinances.

NOISE & VIBRATION

Backup alarms must stay on for safety per Washington Industrial Safety and Health Act (WISHA).

DELIVERIES

Trucks enter from 228th Ave. NE on the west side of the job site.

CLEAN WATER

The team makes sure that only clean rain water leaves the site.

WORKER RULES

All workers must follow Cornerstone and Lake Washington School District's job site policies and safety rules.
