WE ARE YORKVILLE: A strong community of dedicated students, talented employees, loyal residents and supportive business partners who, through education, work together to enrich society. The approximately 7,000 students served by Yorkville Community Unit School District 115 are housed within six elementary schools, an intermediate school, a middle school, and a high school that are located approximately 60 miles southwest of Chicago and 18 miles west of Naperville on Illinois Route 34, extending into Grundy and Kendall counties. Although with approximately 18,000 residents, Yorkville is no longer considered a small-town, Yorkville Schools prides itself on maintaining its close-knit community feel while providing its students with opportunities to graduate well-prepared to further their education or secure employment after high school.

YORKVILLE HIGH SCHOOL is a public, four-year comprehensive high school with 154 faculty members who serve the area's 2,200 high school students, approximately 520 of whom are seniors. - The State of Illinois requires that an Illinois and U.S. Constitution test be passed prior to graduation from high school. This test is taken in conjunction with the Civics course.
- Unit of credits: A .5 credit is awarded for each course per semester.
- An (*) by a given course on the transcript indicates a weighted value.
- Indian Valley Vocational Center courses award 2.5- 3 credits per year.
- Dual Credit: Joint agreement with Waubensee Community College (WCC) for the following courses: Eng 101/102 , MTH 107/109/211, CIS 110/115/122/205, AST 100, GEO 100/101 and EDU 200/202.
