SUBJECT: AIS Mathematics

GRADE: 6

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

AIS targets the math concepts that cause student difficulty by addressing the root causes of these misconceptions. The focus in AIS is on understanding the concept, not merely answering the question.

Academic Intervention Services (AIS) are designed to help students achieve the learning standards in English Language Arts and Mathematics in grades K – 12. Once achieved, students will exit the AIS Mathematics course. Learning and assessments are facilitated by the SuccessMaker program which is individualized to target specific learning goals and conceptual understandings for each student.
