WHAT IS THE PERMANENT SCHOOL FUND?

Minnesota's Permanent School Fund is a more than \$2 billion endowment created to support Minnesota public schools.

The fund receives revenue from Minnesota's school trust lands and investments.

The fund already provides money to every public school district in Minnesota, including Hayfield.

WHAT WOULD CHANGE?

If approved by Minnesota voters:

- ✓ More of the Permanent School Fund's resources could be distributed to Minnesota schools each year
- ✓ Every public school district in Minnesota would benefit
- ✓ Hayfield Community Schools is estimated to receive approximately **\$20,000 MORE** each year
- ✓ NO new local property taxes
- ✓ NO new individual income taxes

GOOD TO KNOW

- The Permanent School Fund is protected in the Minnesota Constitution.
- Funds are distributed to districts based on a formula.
- No new taxes are created by this amendment.
- If approved, more resources from an existing fund will flow to local schools.
