CURRICULUM

The Academic program is based on a 2 term school year with an eight-period school day. Course offerings include Advanced Placement, CAPP, Honors, and Dual Credit. Courses vary for NCAA eligibility requirements.

AP® courses offered: Biology, Environmental Science, Calculus AB and BC, Chemistry, Computer Science A, Computer Science Principles, English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, French, Government and Politics, Physics 1 and C, Psychology, Spanish, Statistics, United States History, and World History. (*Advanced Placement is an open enrollment program.*)

CAPP (Cooperative Academic Placement Program) offers: World language and culture courses including French, Spanish, Accounting, Intro to Teaching, and Spanish Literature.

Honors(*) classes: English 9 & 10, French 4, Spanish 4, Precalculus, Humanities, Band, Orchestra, Intro and Principles of Engineering, and World Literature & Composition.

Dual Credit(+) offered: Advanced Culinary, Civil Engineering, Child Development, Criminal Justice, College Tech Math 1A, English 1, Interpersonal Communications, Marketing, Psychology 1 & 2, Sociology, Small Engines, Written Communications, and Welding.
