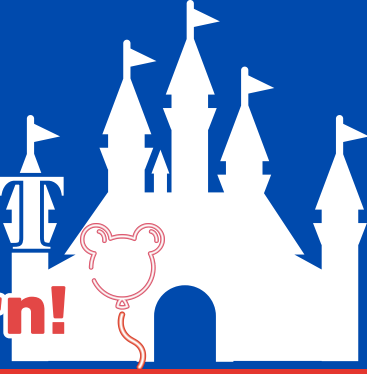

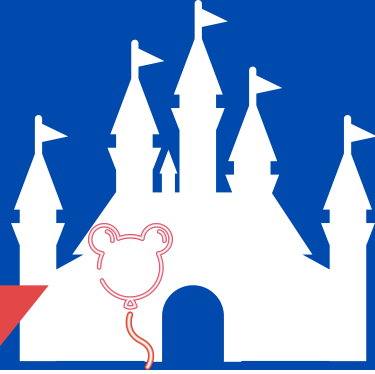

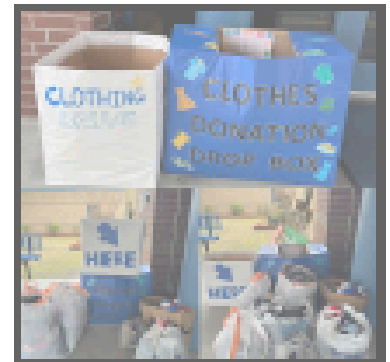

PTO Supported the Community

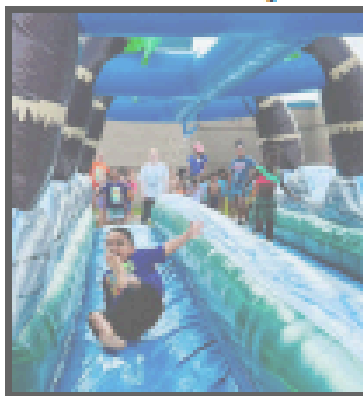
- Paid off balances in lunch accounts for students needing a helping hand staying full during the year;

- Funded tutoring, BrainPOP and Reading Prizes to bolster student success!

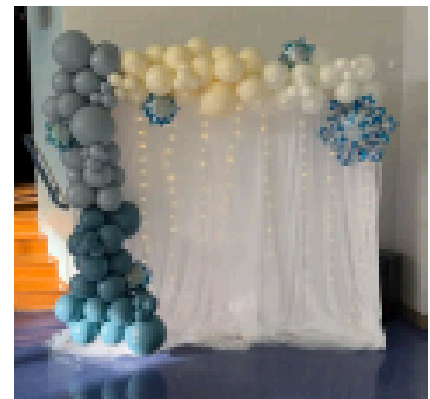

- Captured it all in a fantastic yearbook!



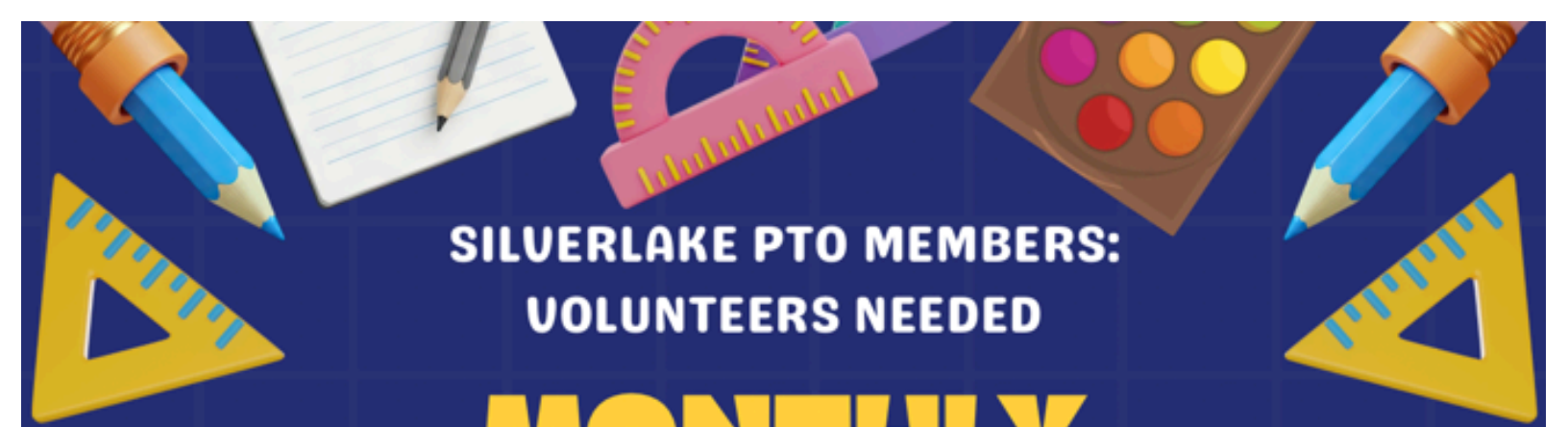
