Opening

1. The President called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. Let the record show that a quorum of board members was present: Present were BJ Sekula, Robert Hons, Stephen Moczygemba, Greg Crawford, David Lee, Kevin Lyssy, and Benny Bordovsky.

Action Items

1. Motion made by Kevin Lyssy to adopt an order calling a bond election to be held on November 3, 2026 that includes: Measure A in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$7,500,000 for the purposes of designing, constructing, renovating, improving, upgrading, updating, modernizing, acquiring, and equipping school facilities (and any necessary or related removal of existing facilities) and the purchase of new school buses and security devices for school buses. The motion was seconded by BJ Sekula. The motion passed with BJ Sekula, David Lee, Kevin Lyssy, Benny Bordovsky, and Greg Crawford voting for and Robert Hons and Stephen Moczygemba voting against.
2. Motion made by BJ Sekula to adopt an order calling a bond election to be held on November 3, 2026 that includes: Measure B in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$3,500,000 for the purposes of renovating, improving, upgrading, updating, modernizing, and equipping the existing Falls City Baseball Field, which is to be leased by the District from the City of Falls City, Texas for student use, and designing, constructing, renovating, improving, upgrading, updating, modernizing, acquiring, and equipping new softball facilities. The motion was seconded by Benny Bordovsky. The motion passed with BJ Sekula, David Lee, Kevin Lyssy, Benny Bordovsky, and Greg Crawford voting for and Robert Hons and Stephen Moczygemba voting against.
