Hello 2026-2027! The Stanislaus STATS team is excited to support your efforts this year. This is year two of our STATUS newsletter, and expect to see additional issues aligned with critical junctions during the year, such as grading periods and pre-summative state assessment test prep. New this year, we'll send your district physical copies to post in work rooms or other high-traffic areas.

➤ 1.0 to 2.0 Migration Project

A major project this year will be streamlining our data into one environment. When the STATS project began several years ago, we needed two environments to address the different student information systems that our partners use (like Aeries and PowerSchool). The goal has always been to unify everything into one. Doing so will allow for greater efficiency, easier data verification and quality control, and visualization consistency. We will address that this year by migrating our 1.0 data and users (stanislauscoek12.hoonuit.com) to the 2.0 environment (stanislausco.hoonuit.com).

What does this mean for you? Because all of this work will be done in the background, you won't see any interruption in your access to or use of the dashboards. At some point during the school year (likely in 2027), anyone logging into stanislauscoek12.hoonuit.com will be asked to log into stanislausco.hoonuit.com instead. While there may be some minor differences in layout and metric cards, for all intents and purposes it will be the same experience. The navigation, filters, and data-related dashboards will be the same. Users new to the 2.0 environment may need to update a few things, such as user-created groups, but the lift should be very light.

We will share updates throughout the year and provide resources to support the transition. We may ask for help from some users in testing access or ensuring the appropriate data is available. If you have any questions, don't hesitate to reach out.

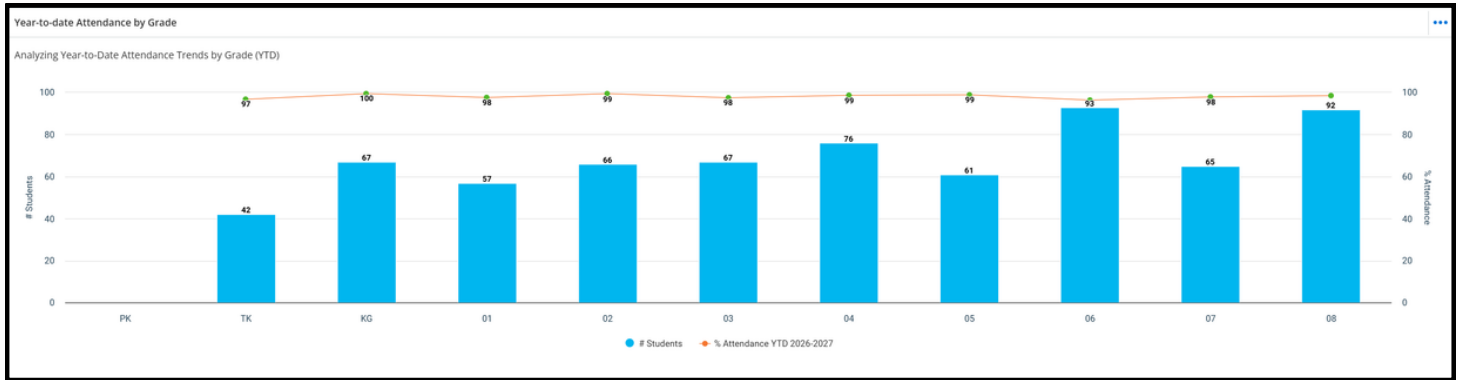


EXAMPLES OF WHAT'S NEW

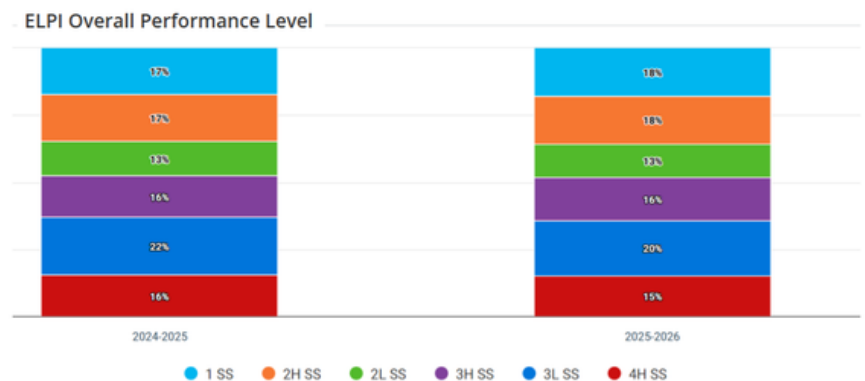
➤ The Attendance Overview Dashboard now has metrics that:

- Compare Year-To-Date attendance by grade
- Show individual student totals for absences and types of absence

➤ John Campbell has created an **English Learner Progress Indicator (ELPI) Dashboard** to support work related to English Learner progress. Currently it has a metric that displays the overall ELPI performance levels based on the state's scale score rubric. A Gainers Stickers Sliders metric, which will align more closely with the CA Dashboard ELPI accountability metric, is in development.
