

Graduating with the Louisiana State Seal of Biliteracy

In high school, students who maintain their bilingual skills may qualify for the **Louisiana State Seal of Biliteracy**, which is awarded at graduation. This official recognition appears on the student's diploma and celebrates fluency in both English and another language.

To qualify, students must:

1. Meet graduation requirements in English Language Arts
2. Score 19 or higher on the Reading and English sections of the ACT.
3. Demonstrate Spanish proficiency through one of the following:
 - o Complete 4 years of Spanish courses in high school
 - o Earn 7+ Carnegie Units in a Spanish immersion program
 - o Score 4 or higher on the AP Spanish exam
 - o Score *Intermediate High* or higher on the STAMP test

CALCASIEU PARISH SPANISH IMMERSION ARTICULATION ORGANIZATIONAL CHART 2022-2023

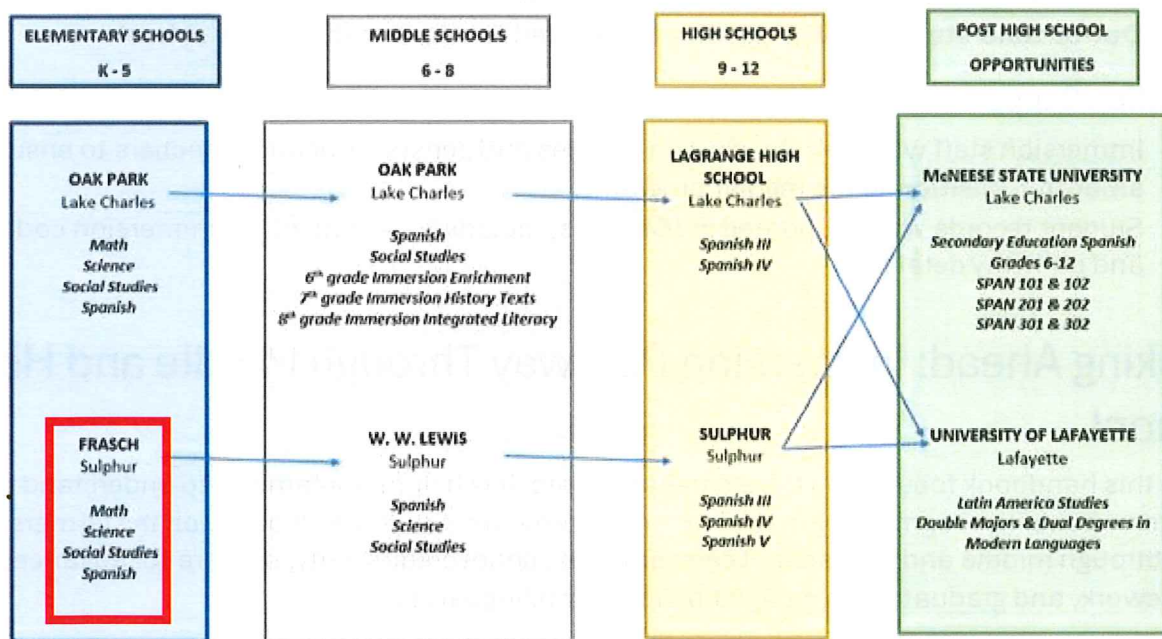


FIGURE 1.4 Calcasieu Parish Spanish Immersion Articulation Organizational Chart 2022-2023
