

Glossary

CODOFIL	– Council for the Development of French in Louisiana; an agency that supports French and Spanish language education in Louisiana and they collaborate with the LDOE and the Louisiana Consortium of Immersion Schools to bring in teachers from various countries.
DCA	– District Common Assessments
DIBELS	– Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills.
DLI	– Dual Language Immersion programs
International Associate Teacher	– Certified native speaker hired via state exchange programs.
LDOE	– Louisiana Department of Education
OWI	– One Way Immersion
Probationary Status	– Designates a student not meeting literacy benchmarks.
SBLC	– School Building Level Committee: a general education, data driven, decision-making committee whose standing members consist of at least the principal/designee, a classroom teacher, and the referring teacher.
SLT	– Students' Learning Target
STAMP	– ST andards-based M easurement of P roficiency; a World Languages proficiency test by Avant. These tests are taken during Middle School.
STAMP 4se	– a World Languages proficiency test for 5 th Grade
WL	– World Language
