The supplies listed below are necessary to begin the school year. We send you the list to help you shop during the summer and to give you some idea of those materials we consider necessary to assist in your child's learning. Obviously, as materials are consumed, they need to be replaced. **The first day of school for the 2026-2027 school year will be September 2, 2026.** In addition to providing your child with necessary supplies, we request that all textbooks be properly covered. Please do not attach tape to textbooks. Book covers should be inspected periodically and replaced when worn or unsightly.

CHILDREN'S SUPPLIES FOR SEPTEMBER
KINDERGARTEN

No backpacks with wheels unless accompanied by a doctor's note. (If brought to school, the child will be required to carry it upon entering the building.)

- 1 Bookbag (no back packs with wheels)
- 1 pair of Headphones (not earbuds, no wireless) – in zip lock bag labeled with child's name
- 1 **Green** Marble composition notebook, wide ruled with child's name on it. Label it Science
- 1 **Blue** Marble composition notebook, wide ruled with child's name on it. Label it For Fun
- 1 **Yellow** Marble composition notebook, wide ruled with child's name on it. Label it Poems
- 1 **Yellow Plastic** Folder with bottom pockets – Label it Writing with child's name
- 1 **Green Plastic** Folder with bottom pockets – Label it Science with child's name
- 2 Fun Folders (design or favorite characters etc.) with bottom pockets – Label them Homework with child's name
