- Suicidal Ideation
- Homicidal Ideation
- Audio/Visual Hallucinations
- Behavioral Outbursts (at home or school)

Law Enforcement Crisis Intervention Team (CIT Team)

This team will include law enforcement members & a mental health specialist.

Parent can call 911 to request assistance from this team

Reasons to request Assistance from Law Enforcement CIT

- Suicidal Ideation with a plan
- Homicidal Ideation with a plan
- Psychosis (Delusions, hallucinations/paranoia)
- Emotionally Distressed & or aggressive behaviors

Coordinated Entry is a tool designed to ensure that homeless persons and persons at risk of homelessness are matched as quickly as possible with the intervention that will most efficiently and effectively ends their homelessness. The El Paso COC has designed the Coordinated Entry (CE) system to coordinate and strengthen access to housing for families and individuals who are homeless or at risk of homelessness throughout El Paso County. The CE system institutes consistent and uniform assessment and referral processes to determine and secure the most appropriate response to each individual or family's immediate and long-term housing needs.
