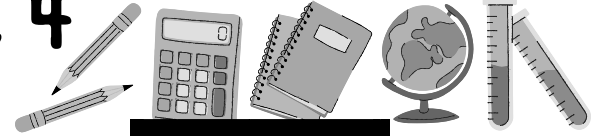


4TH GRADE NEWSLETTER
