Student Absences - IMPORTANT CHANGES for the 2026-27 School Year!!

As of 2026 school year, the Marysville Exempted Village School District no longer utilizes the same attendance protocol. There is a new way to report your students absences, and there are a couple of ways that a parent can access it.

Helpful Hints:

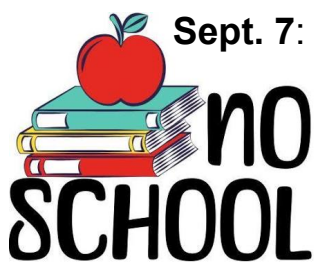
- If you have more than one student please make sure you are on the correct students PowerHub- You can change your student on the upper left hand side of your PowerHub
- Please be sure to have your student's school ID number available when setting up your account. You can access your child's 5-digit student ID number via your PowerSchool Parent Portal account.
- A PaySchools Central app on the registration page is available as well for your convenience.



If your student is going to be absent from school, please contact the **attendance reporting line** at **(855) 876-7974** and follow the automated prompts.

You can also report your student's absence online by going to your **PowerSchool Parent Account** and clicking on the **MyPowerHub** tab where the **SafeArrival Link** will allow you to report an absence for your student.

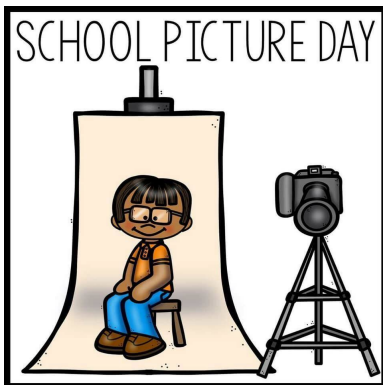

Sept. 16: FALL SCHOOL PICTURES - SMILE :)



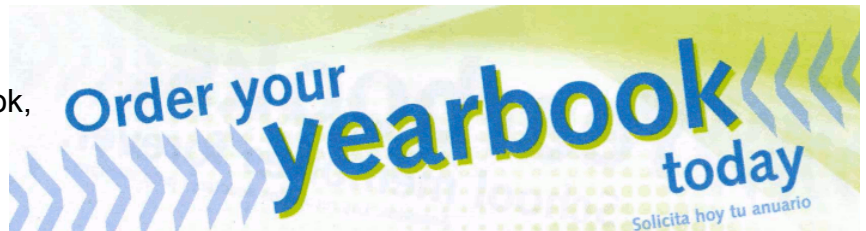

Reminders

★ Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up Area

The student drop-off/pick-up area is in the main parking lot in front of the school. Parent vehicles **MUST** remain in line and students are to be dropped off and picked up **along the main front sidewalk**. In order to keep the traffic flowing, please have your student exit/enter the vehicle quickly and depart in a timely manner.. **Students will not be permitted to be dropped off or picked up in the parking area and walk through traffic. Also, Parents should NOT park in the parking lot and walk over to the pick up line to retrieve their child.**

Parking and Traffic Flow Reminders: As you may know, traffic congestion during the start of school and dismissal causes gridlock on Creekview Drive. We ask again, that parents and students obey traffic laws, demonstrate common courtesy, comply with our crossing guards and campus supervisors, and think safety first!

★ Late Arrivals & Early Dismissals

Late Arrivals: Parents do not need to come into the building when dropping off late students. If your student is going to be late to school, please drop them off at the main school entrance (A). They need to ring the door- bell and will be buzzed into the building. Please have them bring their note into the office where we will get them signed in and off to class.

Early Dismissals: If you need to pick your child up early, please send a note or email (**with student's first and last name**) to school with your child on the day of early pick up. If somebody other than a parent/guardian will be picking your child up, please include their first & last name in the note (email) signed by the parent/guardian. We will NOT release your child to ANYONE other than a parent/guardian without proper notification from the parent/guardian. Upon arrival to pick up, we ask that you ring the bell at the school main entrance (A) where you will be let into the main office. The office staff will ask to see your (or designated person picking up) valid ID. Once your (or designated person's) ID has been verified the person picking up will be asked to sign the student out in the front office. We will get your student to the office as quickly as possible.

★ Normal School Day Hours

Arrival: Creekview interior doors will open at 8:15 a.m. Students dropped off prior to 8:15 a.m. will not have access to the building. The tardy bell rings at 8:35 a.m. Students not in their homeroom at 8:35 a.m., will be marked tardy.

Dismissal: All Creekview students will be dismissed at 3:15 p.m.

★ Students going home different than their “Normal Procedure”

Anytime your child will be going home after school different from their “Normal Procedure”, please send in a note (or email) to your child’s teacher. You may also call the front office at (937) 578-6600 to report a change in your child’s dismissal. ***Please include your child’s first and last name.*** If somebody other than a parent/guardian will be picking up your child, please include their name in the note signed by a parent/guardian.

PLEASE NOTE: A bus student cannot take a friend home on the bus unless PRIOR permission is given by the District Transportation Department.

★ Change in Address:

If your permanent residency address has changed, please notify the board of education office immediately. You may email your change of address form & new proof of residency to enrollment@mevsd.us

You will be required to fill out a change of address form and provide a new proof of residency - The following are accepted: *current gas, electric or water bill that has your or your spouse’s name and address on it. It can also be a screen printing of an online gas, electric or water bill as long as the company name, your or your spouse’s name and address are showing. *Lease or rental agreement SIGNED by both the Landlord and yourself *Mortgage Statement *signed purchase agreement or settlement statement for a new home. (must be followed up with a gas, water or electric bill) *If you are living with another family and do not have any of the above in your name, a Residency Affidavit must be completed, notarized and returned with one of the bills above in the home owner’s name. / [Required Change of Address Form \(Versión en español\)](#)

★ Text Messaging Service Opt In

Marysville Schools utilizes the SchoolMessenger system to deliver text messages, straight to your mobile phone with important information about events, school closings, safety alerts and more.

You can participate in this free service *just by sending a text message of “Y” or “Yes” to our school’s short coder number, **67587**.

You can also opt out of these messages at any time by simply replying to one of our messages with “Stop”.
