Franklin County is expanding opportunities in technology, cybersecurity, and workforce development thanks to a \$10,000 grant from Duke Energy supporting new programs designed to introduce students and adults to in-demand career pathways and industry certifications.

The initiative focuses on a long-term goal of recruiting, retaining, and bridging participants into information technology and cybersecurity careers. Through hands-on learning, career exposure, and certification opportunities, participants will build valuable technology skills while exploring pathways into the growing IT and cybersecurity workforce.

Funding will support three key initiatives in Franklin County:

Teaching Technology Together (T3) Academy: Provides K-12 teachers and students with hands-on technology experiences, from foundational digital skills to mobile app development, web design, video production, and game creation.

Integrated Technology Clubs (ITCs): Introduces technology-focused clubs at Franklin County Schools, including eSports competition, skill development, and opportunities to earn industry certifications.

Entrepreneurship & Digital Literacy Training: Expands access to entrepreneurship, small business, and digital literacy certification training through programming at the Franklin County Sheriff's Department.

Participants will also connect with technology professionals, explore career pathways, and develop industry-recognized skills. With cybersecurity playing an increasingly important role in protecting critical infrastructure, these programs will help strengthen Franklin County's technology workforce pipeline.
