- A. Approve the CEQA Categorical Exemption for the Rosamond High Early College Campus Career Technical Education Building – *Irving* ACTION

The Southern Kern Unified School District proposes to construct a new approximately 17,747-square-foot Career Technical Education building at Rosamond High Early College Campus, located at 2925 West Rosamond Boulevard in Rosamond. The purpose of the project is to create modern Career Technical Education facilities for students of the District. The project will contain fewer than ten classrooms and will not increase the school's student enrollment capacity.

The project qualifies for a Class 14 categorical exemption under the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15314, which applies to minor additions to existing schools within existing school grounds when the addition does not increase original student capacity by more than 25 percent or ten classrooms, whichever is less. The project is located entirely within the existing school campus, contains fewer than ten classrooms, and will not increase the school's student capacity.

District staff has reviewed the project and determined that none of the exceptions to the use of a categorical exemption identified in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 applies. The project will not result in a significant cumulative environmental impact; there are no unusual circumstances that would result in a significant environmental effect; and the project will not adversely affect scenic, historical, or hazardous-waste resources.
