BOTTOMS

Gray Uniform Pants

NOT PERMITTED

- Leggings, jeggings, yoga pants
- Shorts, skirts, or pants above the knee
- Hoodies or outerwear worn inside the building
- Headwear (hats, caps, bonnets, durags, etc.)
- Slides, crocs, slippers, sandals
- Inappropriate logos, graphics, or writing
- Visible undergarments
- Ripped or overly distressed clothing

CONSEQUENCES FOR VIOLATING THE UNIFORM POLICY

All violations will be addressed respectfully and consistently.

1ST OFFENSE

- Reminder of the uniform policy
- Verbal warning
- Uniform correction (if available)
- Parent/guardian notification
- Documented in student record

2ND OFFENSE

- Mandatory In-School Restoration (ISR) during instructional time
- Parent/guardian notification
- Uniform correction
- Documented in student record

3RD OFFENSE

- After School Detention OR Saturday Detention
- Parent/guardian notification
- Possible Home for Parent (Parent Conference Required before returning to school)
- Documented in student record



HOME FOR PARENT

If a scholar continues to violate the uniform policy after the 3rd offense, they may be assigned Home for Parent. A parent or guardian must attend a conference with school administration before the scholar can return.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS
