Roofing projects have continued for both Freeman and Nelson, with contractors working on the cap sheet for both buildings.

A "cap sheet" is the top layer (the final protective roofing layer) that serves as the weather-resistant outer layer of a low-slope or flat roof. This layer helps protect the roof from:

- Rain and moisture
- Sun/UV exposure
- Temperature changes
- Wind and weather
- General wear and tear

The Freeman walkway continues to make great progress! Contractors poured the slab this week, and plan to install the steel this upcoming week.
