Parents are assigned a unique **Access Code**. You will use this code to create your Schoology account. ***You will find this Access Code in HAC.***

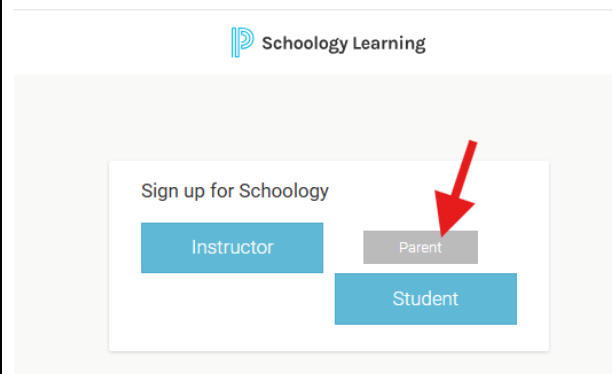

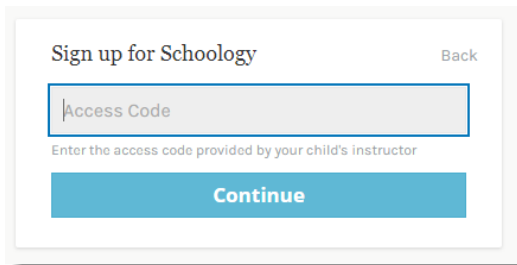

2. Select **Parent**

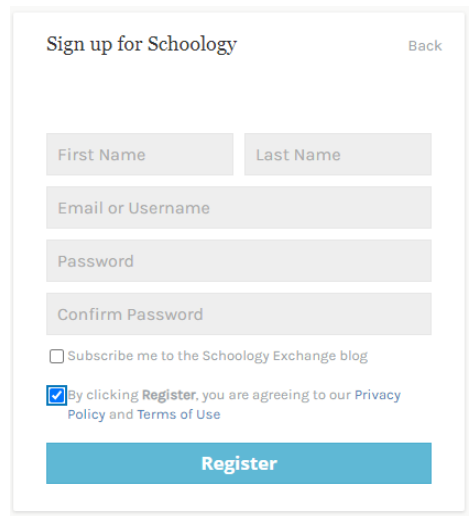


3. Input the Parent **Access Code** sent to you.



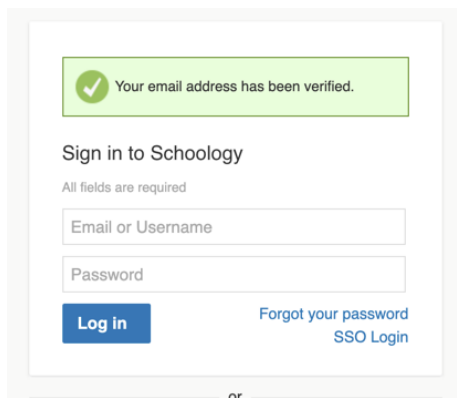

4. Fill in all fields, selecting a password of your choice. You must check the second box.



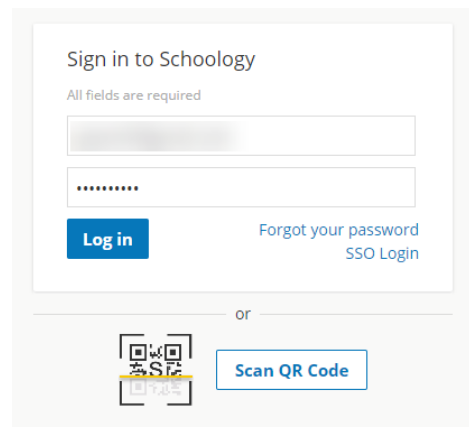

5. You will receive an email with a link to verify your account. You can then Sign in to Schoology.



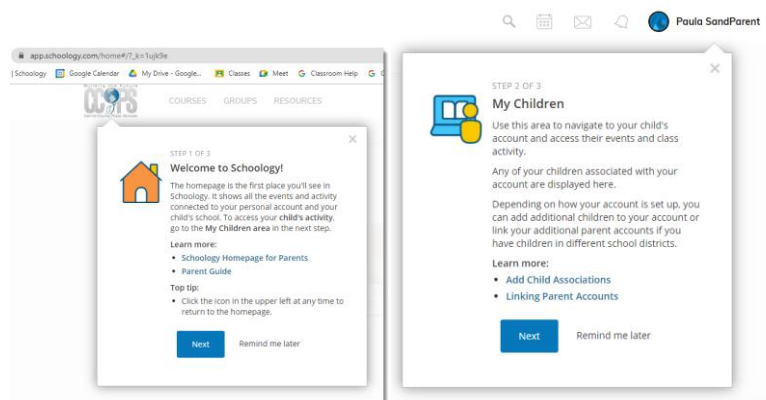

6. On subsequent visits, go to Schoology.com/login and Sign in using your email and password you created.



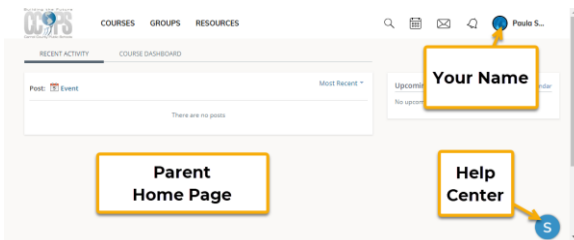

7. When you have successfully logged in for the first time, you may see a series of popup windows introducing you to some of Schoology's features.

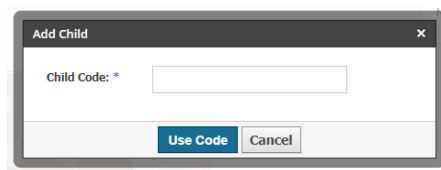
