The children are expected to answer in complete sentences, start with capitals, and end with correct punctuation. They are to restate the question in the answer.

Examples:

These examples restate the question and are in complete sentences:

1. Where does Bob live?
Bob lives in the blue house.
2. Where is the snake hiding?
The snake is hiding in the grass.
3. What is Beth's job?
Beth's job is to water the plants.

We don't want these types of answers:

1. Where does Bob live?
in a house
2. Where is the snake hiding?
The grass.
3. What is Beth's job?
water plants
