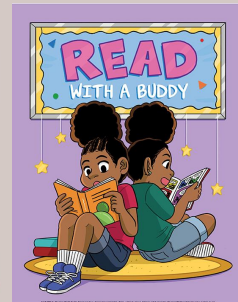




All About Mrs. Stone
