College Rep Visits

You need to sign up in advance (in SCOIR) AND get permission from your teachers. Please do not sign up and NOT show; this reflects poorly on you and us. Remember, these visits are a fantastic opportunity to connect with the admission officer who will review your application.

College Visits to Campus/Career Exploration

Seniors receive 3 visits per year and a **College Visit/Job Shadow Form must be completed 3 days in advance.** These forms are located in the Counseling Office and on Canvas.

Scholarships & Special Programs

This week we are highlighting the [Thurgood Marshall Scholarship Fund](#). Other "3rd Party Scholarships" (scholarships that follow you wherever you enroll) are available on Canvas. In addition, the application for the [Miami University Bridges Program](#) is available and due September 21st. The Bridges Program is an engaging experience that provides an inside look at Miami University to prospective students. This program invites 1st generation students and/or students with financial need to engage with our current students, faculty, and staff. Students who attend the program are eligible for additional scholarships.

TESTING INFORMATION

- **PSAT/NMSQT is October 21th.** On this day, each grade level will participate in a different educational option experience related to college and career. For many of our students, this is the day they will take the PSAT/NMSQT to assess their current level of college readiness. Other students will have the option to engage in an activity that will provide them with further insight about themselves and/or their chosen career path.
 - 9th Grade- YouScience assessment and activity (must bring school Chromebook).

 - 10th Grade- Digital PSAT/NMSQT (must bring school Chromebook CHARGED).
Students will be dismissed at 10:45 A.M.
 - 11th Grade
 - Optional Digital PSAT/NMSQT for National Merit Scholarship **Students will be dismissed at 10:45 A.M.** (must bring school Chromebook CHARGED);
 - or Ed-Option Day experience (college visit, service/volunteer, or job shadow). Only juniors taking the PSAT should report to school.

 - 12th Grade- Ed-Option experience. **Seniors do not report to school.**

Student Drivers:

We appreciate our student drivers and their efforts to arrive at school on time, but safety for them and for our community comes first. Please remind student drivers to follow all traffic laws and drive with care on the way to and from school. Many community members, including young children walking alone or with their families, rely on drivers to be alert and cautious. Students should plan their departure time so they can travel safely and still arrive on time. Thank you for helping us keep everyone safe.

Instructional Fees:

At the beginning of each school year, instructional fees are assessed based on each student's grade level and/or course/class load. Families can pay existing fee balances at any point online via the [Wyoming PaySchools portal](#).

Any new fees for the 2026-2027 school year will be applied to your student's account the first week of September. At which point, families can use the same [Wyoming PaySchools portal](#) to pay these newly applied fees.

Wyoming City Schools strives for financial stewardship and wants to partner with families to ensure fees are paid in a timely manner. Fees are due by October 31 and school buildings will send fee reminders throughout the year. Instructional fee waivers are processed for those students who qualify for free lunch and complete the paperwork required for fee waivers. Applications for free lunch are available [here](#) through our nutrition services partner, Milford City Schools.

Implications for Non-Fee Payment

If a student is not up-to-date with payment of student fees (or is not current with their payment plan with the Treasurer), the following privileges will be withheld each year:

- 7-12 Dances (e.g. Homecoming, Prom, etc)
- 9-12 Class Shirts
- Junior/Senior Parking Spots
- Senior Class Trip (e.g. Washington D.C.)
- Graduation Tickets
- College Transcripts

For example, if a student, who has not paid their fees, goes to purchase a Homecoming ticket, PaySchools would not allow them to make the purchase.
