What is School Site Council?



A School Site Council (SSC) is a group of teachers, parents, administrators, and interested community members who work together to develop and monitor a school's improvement plan.

It is a legally required decision-making body for any school receiving federal funds.

There are 5 elected parent positions.

Who are the families that support FFA?

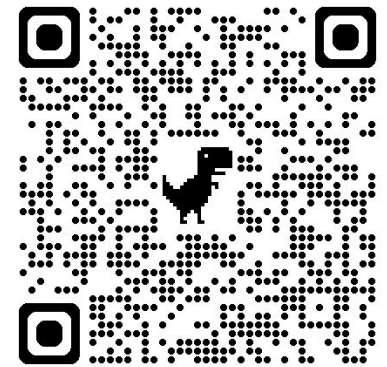
Any parent/guardian of a student in any FFA class are invited to attend.

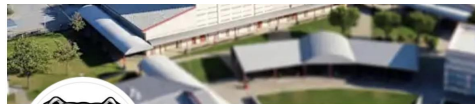
