School Data Sheets - Overview

The following data sheets provide a snapshot into each operating school in the St. Louis Public Schools building portfolio and are intended to provide a consistent view of building-level conditions and offerings. The district has also used a wide variety of other information to make recommendations to improve the system for our students and staff. The information found in these data sheets is not to be interpreted as a final recommendation or decision.

Weighted Evaluation Criteria

For purposes of this analysis, five factors were weighted to provide a consistent framework for evaluating each operating school.

A. Facility Condition Index (FCI) --- 25% of total score

Total Cost of Deferred Maintenance divided by the Current Replacement Value

For this analysis, the district used each building's 10-year FCI percentage.

B. Building Capacity --- 25% of total score

C. Building Utilization --- 20% of total score

Current Enrollment divided by Building Capacity

D. Number of SLPS Students Living in Attendance Area --- 15% of total score

This figure represents the number of students within the school's grade span for whom this is the closest SLPS school.

E. Percentage of SLPS Students Living within One Mile Attending this Site --- 15% of total score
