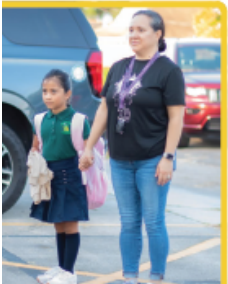
CARPOOL SAFETY GUIDELINES



LET'S KEEP
OUR KIDS SAFE!

DRIVER/CARPOOL SAFETY

- ✓ Cell phone use is prohibited in the carpool lines to ensure we keep our students and employees safe.
- ✓ Obey **ALL** stop signs and stop at **ALL** crosswalks.
- ✓ Have carpool signs clearly displayed.
- ✓ Drive **slowly** in the school parking lot and the carpool area.
- ✓ Do not pull out of the carpool line to go around cars. **PLEASE wait** for the car in front of you to move.
- ✓ **STAY IN YOUR CAR.** Our employees will help your child into and out of the car.
- ✓ Before reaching the carpool lane in the a.m., have your kids ready to exit the car. **HOWEVER**, students **must remain** in a passenger restraint until the vehicle comes to a complete stop.
- ✓ Do not store backpacks or belongings in the trunk of your car.
- ✓ **Please be courteous** to our neighbors. **Do not** block driveways and remain **respectful** to neighbors. Parents who block driveways risk being ticketed or towed at their own expense.



PEDESTRIAN/WALKER SAFETY

- ✓ **Only students** designated by the address in JCampus as a walker are dismissed as a walker.
- ✓ Students who are coded as carpool/personnel transportation or who should catch a bus are **not allowed** to walk to a car in the neighborhood or a location designated by the parent.
- ✓ Student must obey the directions of the crossing guards.
- ✓ Student **must not** walk between cars.
- ✓ Parents **may not** use the parking lot as an entry/exit for students.

WE LEARN WE LOVE WE LEAD

Interested 5th graders have accepted responsibilities as school wide Student Leaders. These exceptional students will be invited to act as morning meeting motivators and leaders, provide care to our younger PreK & Kindergarten students in and out of the classroom, act as administrative assistants, and support our students in dismissal as a member of the safety patrol OR as a carpool caller!

Patience...& PULL UP!

We are working to establish the most efficient arrival & dismissal. Take the time to discuss with your child the importance of listening for names to be called....if he or she is **NOT** ready for pick up, we will ask you to pull up to the sidewalk area & wait patiently for your child to come to the breezeway. Also, start implementing **NEW** protocols when you arrive at school. Practice being **READY TO GO** when the door opens. It is expected that **MOST** students (grades 1-5) can exit the vehicle with the belongings with **NO DELAY**. If necessary, you may be asked to "Pull Up & Be Patient" as your child prepares to exit the vehicle safely.

Cooperate with Our Community!

Please be mindful of the **NEIGHBORS** who live near our school. It is important to operate your car legally and respectfully, staying aware of grass and driveways.





Everyone should know Miss Honey (pictured above) who braves the outdoors each day to assist our safe dismissal. Typically, Miss Honey asks for your child's name (prior to 2:00 pm) and reminds you of our carpool procedures. Take a moment to appreciate her efforts and dedication to our community!

Any help is HELPFUL!

We appreciate anytime you are available to support our school, although in person may not be possible at this time! Teachers invite the support of families who have offered to collate papers, record student information, and/or tear out workbook pages. Thank you for sharing your talents (and muscle) in and out of the classroom.



Meals are available for adults and second student meals at cost. The cost of breakfast is \$3.25 and the cost of lunch is \$5.00. Individual food items (i.e. milk, extra entrees, extra bread) may be purchased as well. The cafeteria uses My Payments Plus for electronic payments. Cafeteria payments cannot be made using School Cash Online. Teachers/school staff who wish to pre-pay for meals using My Payments Plus will need to be set up in Horizon OneSource before creating a My Payments Plus account. To be set up, please provide your name and employee ID number to your school's Cafeteria Manager.
