Schoolwide Program

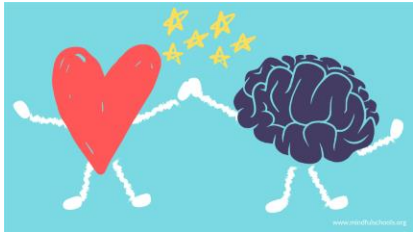
- All students at the school benefit from Title I funds.

- Materials, equipment, technology, professional development, extended learning time, salaries of some teachers, and the Family Center are some of the possible items funded through Title I.



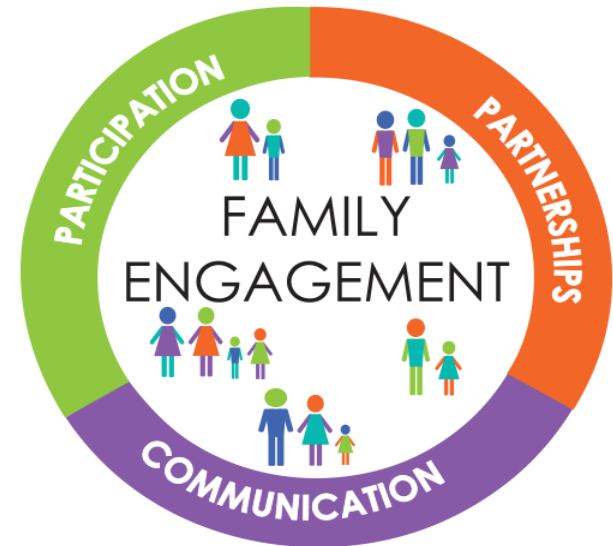
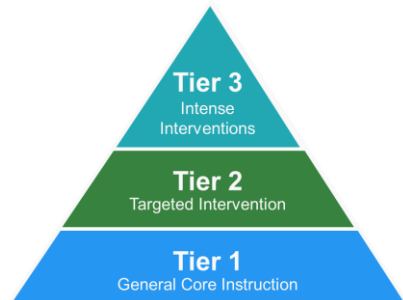
What are our school goals?

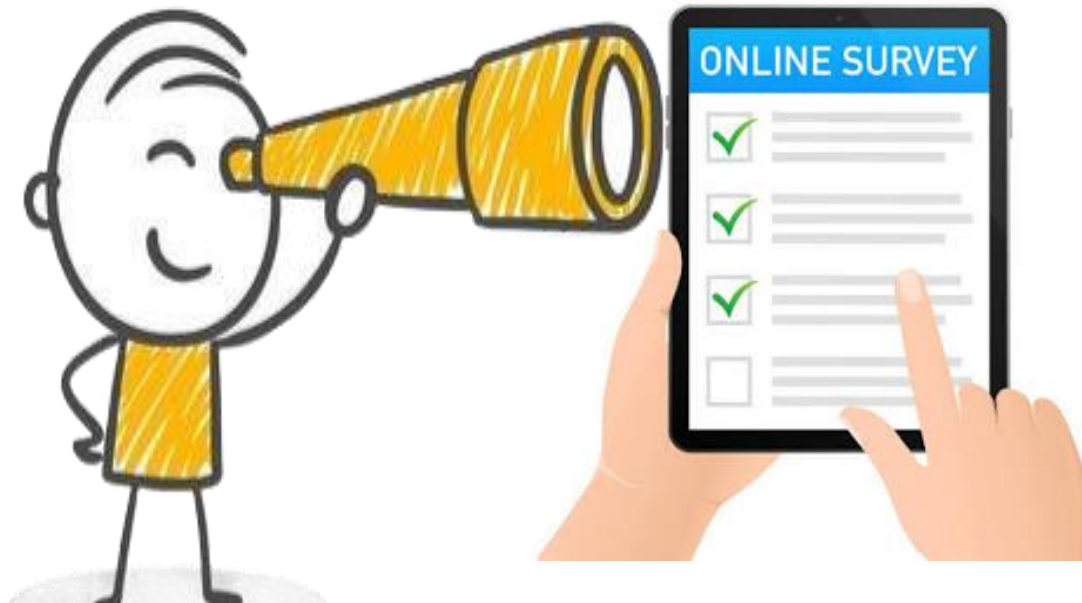

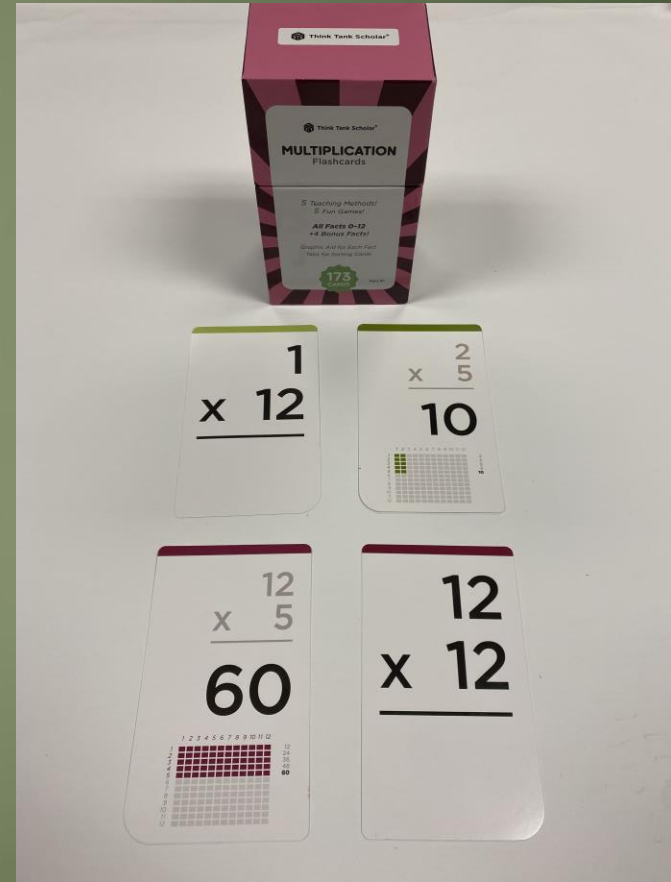
