- District** Established in 1811 the Gallipolis City Schools is located in rural southeast Ohio and covers 99 square miles in an area designated as Appalachian. GCS consists of 5 public schools, three elementary schools, one middle school and one high school, serving approximately 2,000 students annually. The district is ranked in the top 50% of all school districts in Ohio.
- School** Gallia Academy High School is the largest of three public high schools in Gallia County and is a four-year high school (grades 9-12) with an enrollment of around 550 students. Gallia Academy High School offers on-campus College Preparatory coursework. In order to enhance our curriculum, Gallia Academy offers participation in vocational programs through Buckeye Hills Career Center Joint Vocational School, online education through the Gallia Digital Academy and credit recovery through the Gallia-Vinton Educational Service Center and Summer Advantage Program. With over 100 years of continuous accreditation from North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools, Gallia Academy meets or exceeds all requirements of the Ohio Department of Education. Accounting for our intervention specialists, GAHS has a student-teacher ratio of 16:1.

- Graduation Requirements** Students are required to earn twenty-one (21) credits in the following areas for graduation: English- 4 credits; Math- 4 credits (Algebra I, Geometry or Geometry A, Algebra IIA or equivalent, and a math elective); Science- 3 credits (Physical Science, Biology or Biology A, and Advanced Science); Social Studies- 3 credits (including World History, American History, and American Government); Health- 1/2 credit; Physical Education- 1/2 credit (2 semesters- 1/4 credit each); Financial Literacy – 1/2 credit; and Electives- 5 1/2 credits.
- Honors, CCP, & Advanced Placement** Gallia Academy offers the following honors and Advanced Placement (AP) courses: AP United States History, AP United States Government and Politics, AP European History, AP Calculus, Honors Chemistry I, AP English Language & Composition and AP English Literature & Composition. **Honors and AP courses are not weighted.**
