Superintendent's Report – Dr. La'Quetta S. Small welcomed the school district community and shared several announcements. She thanked the high school staff for organizing the freshman orientation program and encouraged the community to enjoy the presentation playing on the screen. The Superintendent also noted that Dr. Hyman would present the district's Harassment, Intimidation, and Bullying (HIB) report, from January 2026 - June 2026. The report findings are as follows: ACHS - 0; NYA - 7; RAS - 2; TAS - 2; CHS - 1; MLK - 7; PAS - 0; UPS - 0; SAS - 0; BAS - 0; and VP - 0. Out of 63 cases, 19 were founded.

Followed by, Mr. Rose providing an update regarding the Administration Building Project. Mr. Rose confirmed the project remains on schedule and was advertised for bid on July 14, 2026. A pre-bid meeting is scheduled for August 13, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. at the Board Office. Bids are due by August 27, 2026, and will be opened thereafter. He anticipates awarding the project at the September 2026 Board meeting. Following contract execution and issuance of the purchase order, construction is expected to proceed, with groundbreaking

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anticipated for late October 2026, pending required permits. The project remains on schedule for occupancy in summer 2028.

Public Comments- There were two public comments:

Mr. Steve Barlage- a community resident and avid tennis player, addressed the Board regarding public access to the high school tennis courts. He requested clarification on how the public can access and use the courts when they are not being used for school purposes.

Mr. Eric Phillips- a community resident, expressed interest in partnering with the Board of Education and provided information about his youth development program, Building Up Youth Academy, LLC.

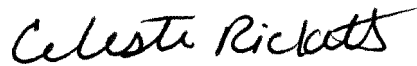
