Student Cellular Phone Registration Form

I understand that state law and school policy specifically prohibit students having a cellular phone on them in school. I am aware that **only** students in grades 6-8 are allowed to enter the building with a phone which they then check in at the start of the day and will have them returned at dismissal. If my child is found to have his/her cellular phone on him/her the privilege to have a cellular phone on school premises will be forfeited. If I need to contact my child, or my child needs to make a call during the day, he/she is not to use his/her cellular phone, he/she will be allowed to use the phone in the main office like any other child. I additionally do not hold any faculty or staff member responsible for my child's cellular phone should they not turn it in at the beginning of the day and it is lost or stolen. I furthermore understand that my child's cellular phone will be confiscated if found on his/her body, or in his/her locker or possessions during the school day. I lastly understand that this policy extends to any device such as smart watches, glasses, ear pods, tablets, or any other device that serves a similar function.
