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Steps to Find Locker Information

North Oneida St / Northland Avenue Road Construction

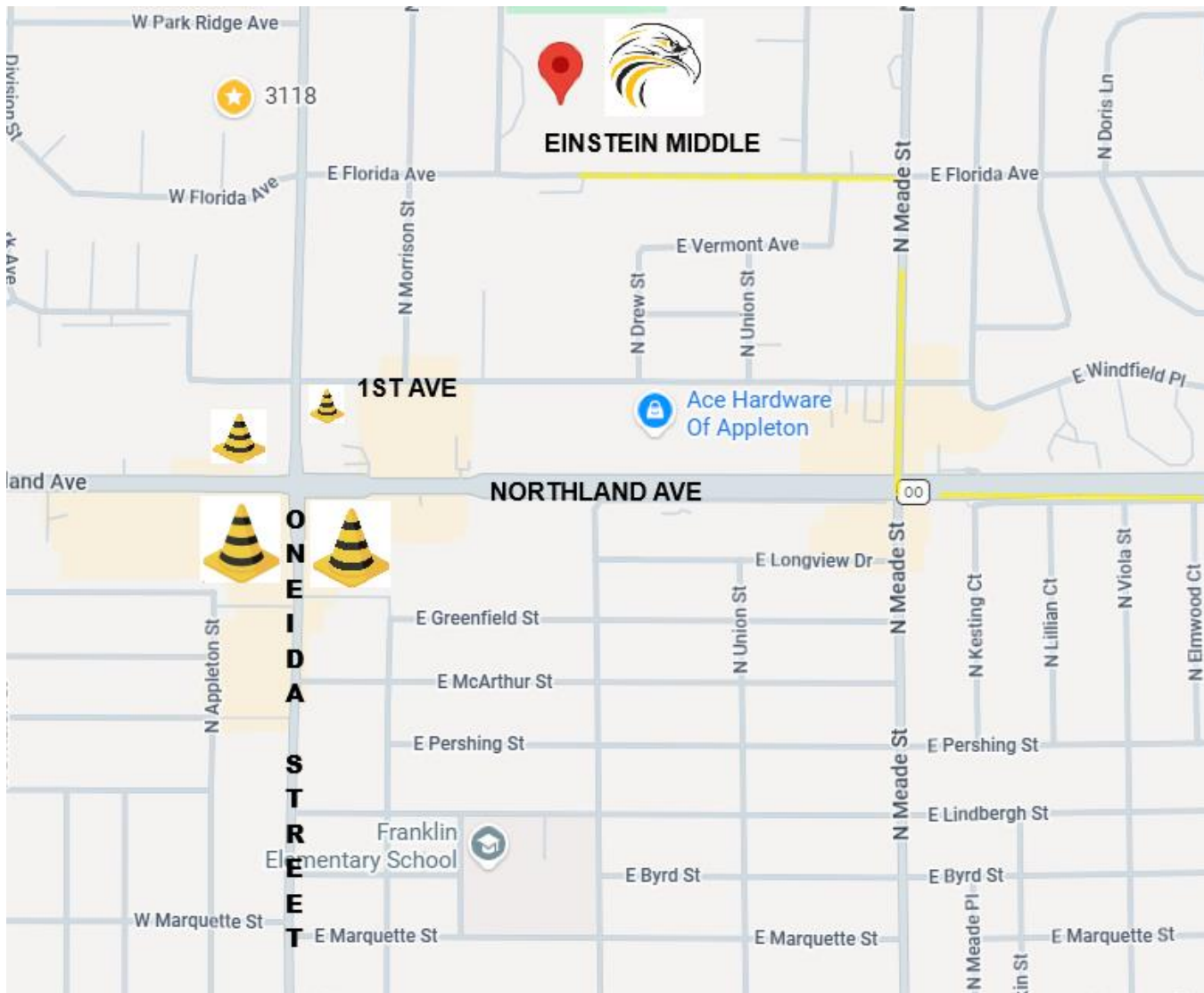

PARKING LOT AND BUS TURN-AROUND USE FOR PARENTS/VISITORS

PLEASE BE VERY CAREFUL NO MATTER WHAT AREA YOU USE FOR PICK UP AND DROP OFF. MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS ARE OFTEN IMPETUOUS AND ARE NOT CAREFUL WHEN THEY ARE IN A HURRY TO GET IN OR OUT OF SCHOOL.

Drop Off

We understand that dropping off your child can be challenging and stressful in the mornings between 7:35-7:45 due to the fact that two other schools on the same block as Einstein start their school day relatively, around the same time.

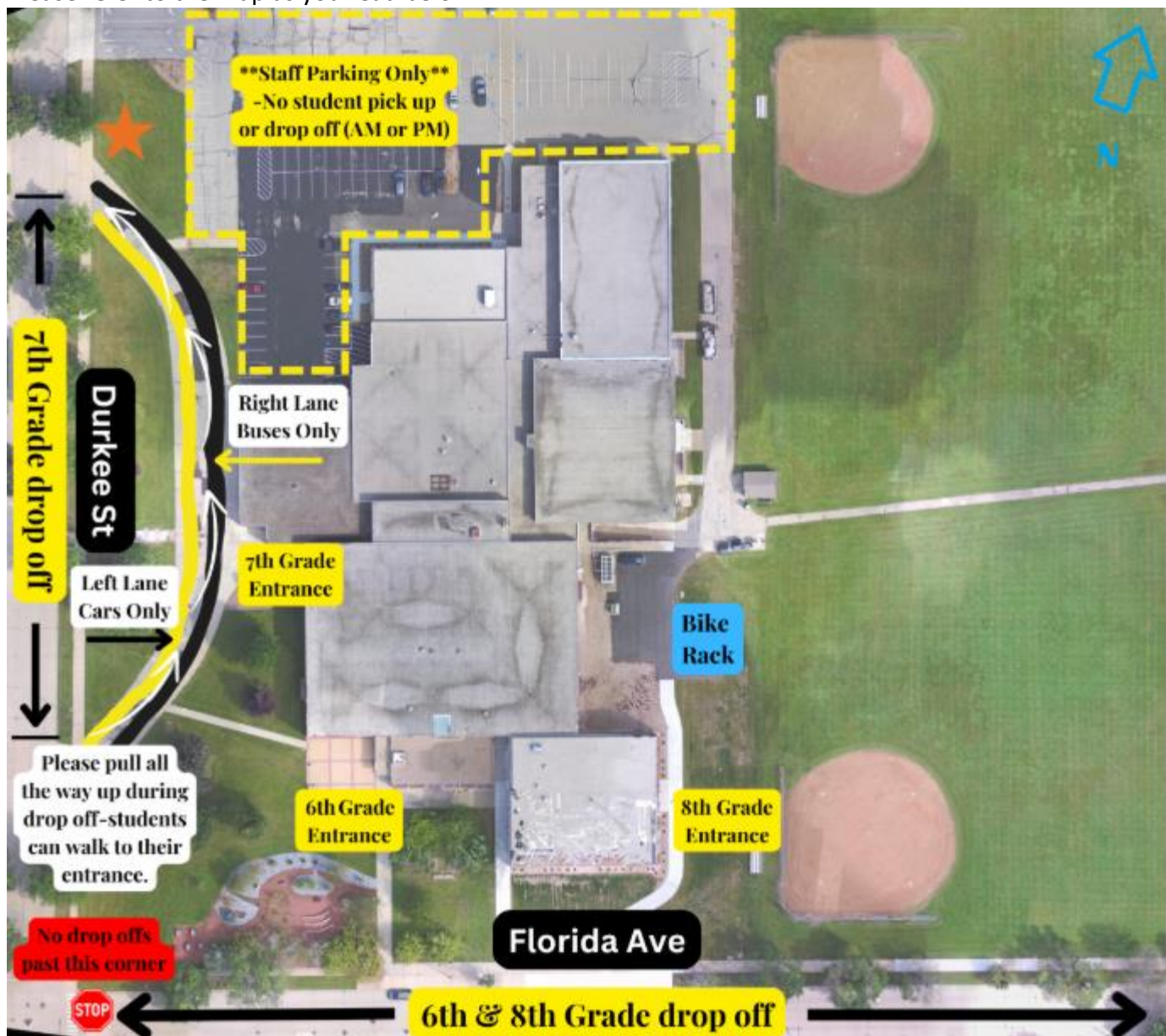
Here are some strategies on where and when to drop off your child in the morning:

If at all possible, consider dropping your child off at Einstein before 7:30 a.m. to avoid the busy traffic.

Breakfast is served in our cafeteria from 7:20-7:45 a.m. each day.

Students with instruments or approved sports equipment will be let into the building 5 minutes early to drop items off at their designated location. Please see your band teacher or coach for more information.

Please refer to the map as you read below.



6th and 8th graders

Your main drop off area will be located on Florida Ave. since both the 6th grade (main entrance A) and 8th grade entrance doors are located on that side of the building. It is best to drop off your child on the north side of Florida Ave., heading westbound so that your child doesn't have to cross the street. Recommended between Durkee St and the track. Please do not wait to pull up to the closest doors. Students can walk to their assigned entrance.

7th graders

Semi-circle drive

If buses are not parked in the designated, right lane of the semi circle drive, you can drop off your child in that right lane.

If buses are present, please use the left lane of the semi-circle drive to drop off your child. Make sure you pull all the way to the front (where the orange star is located on the map) of the semi-circle drive, when busy, so that other cars can fit in the semi-circle drive. This act will alleviate congestion on the corner of Florida Ave. and Durkee St.

Buses usually drop off students around 7:25 a.m. in the semi-circle lane, in front of the 7th grade entrance.

Durkee Street

There is a stretch of road that spans the length of the semi-circle drive along the east side of Durkee St. (indicated on map), **where** you can drop off your child while heading northbound on Durkee St.

Bike Rack is located in blue on the east side of the building and can be accessed by Florida Ave and Einstein's main staff parking lot where entrance to the lot is located on Durkee St. Students should use the parking lot perimeter to get to the bike racks, so as to avoid vehicles entering the main lot. Please make sure students lock up their bikes when they arrive.

Pick Up

The same designated areas apply where to pick up your child in the afternoon. Dismissal is at 3:20 p.m.

No Stopping, Standing or Parking signs: Students may not be dropped off or picked up in this area.

Penalty: \$43.00 parking ticket, or \$132.00 traffic citation.

No Parking signs: Vehicles may stop and stand in this area to drop off or pick up. You may not park and leave your vehicle. Penalty \$20

SPEED LIMIT RESTRICTIONS AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS & OTHER LOCATIONS MARKED WITH SCHOOL CROSSING SIGNS

According to W.S.A. 346.57(4)(b), a 15 miles per hour speed limit is enforced when passing an intersection or other location properly marked with a "school crossing" sign when any of the following conditions exist:

- Any child is present.
- A school crossing guard is within a crosswalk at the intersection or the other location or if no crosswalk exists, is in the roadway at the intersection or the other location.
- A school crossing guard is placing in or removing from the roadway at or near the intersection or the other location a temporary sign or device that guides, warns or regulates traffic.

Please note that only one child needs to be present for a violation to occur. However, a child need not even be present if the school crossing guard is within the crosswalk or if no crosswalk exists then on the roadway. Just for your information crosswalk only applies to the roadway; it does not include the sidewalk or curb. Therefore, if the crossing guard is just standing on the sidewalk with no children present, then a vehicle is not restricted to 15 mph (unless some other law applies). Also, there has been some confusion as to what "the other location" includes. Although most, if not all crossing guards in Appleton, are stationed at intersections within a school zone, the term "the other location" may apply to areas where you have a school crossing that is not located at an intersection or an area that is not within a school zone but is used as a school crossing.

EMS Beverage Policy

To promote a healthy learning environment and keep our students focused and energized, we are updating our student beverage policy this school year. Students will only be permitted to have water in the classroom during the school day. Sugary drinks, sodas, and caffeinated beverages (including energy drinks and iced teas) will no longer be allowed in the classroom.

We encourage students to bring a refillable water bottle to school each day to stay hydrated. Thank you for your support and partnership in keeping our students healthy, focused, and ready to learn!

****Students may choose a drink of choice during the lunch hour but must be fully consumed or discarded after the lunch hour.**

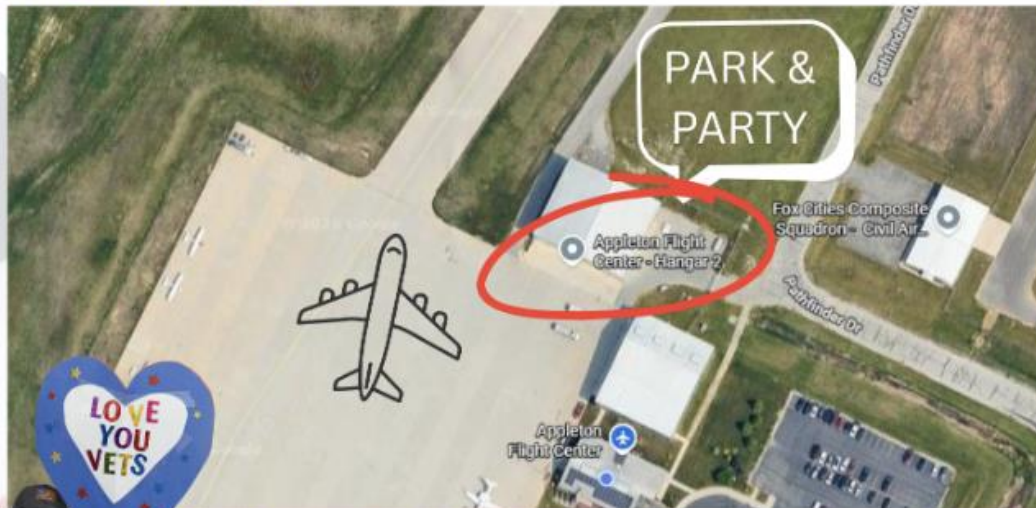

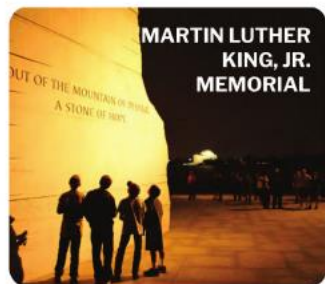
