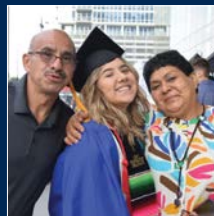

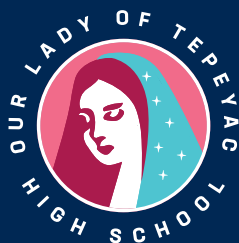

At Tepeyac, we believe every girl deserves a Catholic education. **With 97% of students receiving scholarships or financial aid**, we make it affordable for all families.

Merit awards* (Available when you test at Tepeyac):

Tepeyac Excellence Award	\$7,300 full tuition for the top score on the High School Placement Test given on December 5th.
President's Award	\$1,500 year/renewable (score in the top 10%)
Principal's Award	\$1,000 year/renewable (score in the top 20%)
Sisters of the Resurrection Award	\$750 year/ Renewable (score in the top 40%)
Legacy Award	\$1,000 year/renewable if your mom, sister or grandma graduated from Tepeyac/St. Casimir

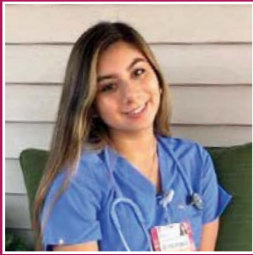

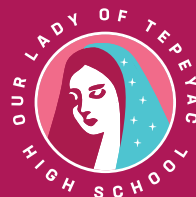
Mission Statement
