

Lorain City Schools Endowment Funds

The Lorain City Schools Funds for Enhancing Education and fine Arts are privately funded endowments managed by The Community Foundation of Lorain County. Lorain City Schools was the first school system in the United States to partner with a community foundation to establish an endowment fund.

Income from the endowments is used to fund projects that help students attending Lorain City Schools learn, grow, and become significant human beings. Teachers and all other district staff can apply for an Endowment Grant to purchase equipment, supplies, and services not available within the regular school budget. These grants provide much need materials and activity funds used to enhance student's educational experiences. For example, grant funds give students the opportunity to tour local museums, see a play, participate in a summer camp, and conduct a community service project. Teachers are also able to use grant funds to purchase items the district would not otherwise be able to provide such as software, musical instruments, graphing calculators, sports equipment, and other supplies to enrich learning.
