September at Millwood!

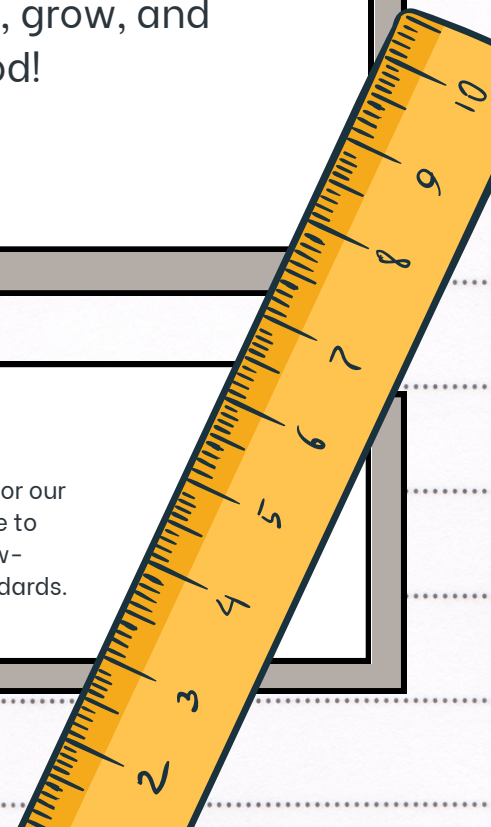
